# A Bill

**HOUSE BILL 1862**

## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND  
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR SOUTHERN ARKANSAS UNIVERSITY - EL  
10 DORADO BRANCH FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30,  
11 1993; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."  
12

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
14

15 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for Southern  
16 Arkansas University - El Dorado Branch for the 1991-93 biennium, the following  
17 maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the  
18 provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code  
19 §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.  
20 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary  
21 is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said  
22 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions  
23 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular  
24 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its  
25 successor.

17 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for Southern  
 18 Arkansas University - El Dorado Branch for the 1991-93 biennium, the following  
 19 maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra  
 20 Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: one hundred  
 21 seventy five (175) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of  
 22 pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and  
 23 Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate  
 24 classification.

26 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS - GENERAL REVENUE. There is hereby  
 27 appropriated, to Southern Arkansas University - El Dorado Branch, to be  
 28 payable from the Southern Arkansas University Fund, or its successor fund, for  
 29 personal services and operating expenses of Southern Arkansas University - El  
 30 Dorado Branch for the biennial period ending June 30, 1993, the following:

10 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATIONS - CASH FUNDS. There is hereby appropriated,  
 11 to Southern Arkansas University - El Dorado Branch, to be payable from cash  
 12 funds as defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of Southern Arkansas University -  
 13 El Dorado Branch, for personal services and operating expenses of Southern  
 14 Arkansas University - El Dorado Branch for the biennial period ending June 30,  
 15 1993, the following:

34 SECTION 5. ADJUNCT AND VISITING PROFESSORS. The Southern Arkansas  
 35 University - El Dorado Branch shall be exempt from the provisions of Arkansas  
 36 Code §19-4-1707 to the extent that the Southern Arkansas University - El

1 Dorado Branch shall be allowed to hire adjunct professors and visiting  
2 professors who are currently providing professional and consulting services to  
3 the State of Arkansas, providing that they are not in a position to influence  
4 decisions regarding the awarding of grants or contracts, and providing that  
5 the term of their employment with the Southern Arkansas University - El Dorado  
6 Branch does not exceed 25% of that required for a full time employee.

7

8       SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
9 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
10 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
11 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and  
12 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
13 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditure Restrictions  
14 Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where  
15 applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and  
16 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in  
17 disbursement of said funds.

19       SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
20 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
21 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which  
22 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
23 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
24 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
25 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
26 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

28       SECTION 8. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent  
29 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
30 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

31

32       SECTION 9. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the  
33 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such  
34 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which  
35 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this  
36 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 10. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 11. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the Seventy-Eighth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1991 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1991 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1991.
