HOUSE BILL 1958

For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND
OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE STATE DEPARTMENT FOR SOCIAL
SECURITY ADMINISTRATION DISABILITY DETERMINATION FOR THE
BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1993; AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the State Department for Social Security Administration Disability Determination for the 1991-93 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

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34 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the State
 35 Department for Social Security Administration Disability Determination, to be
 36 payable from the federal funds as designated by the Chief Fiscal Officer of

1 the State, for personal services and operating expenses of the State
 2 Department for Social Security Administration Disability Determination for the
 3 biennial period ending June 30, 1993, the following:

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 18 SECTION 3. CARRY FORWARD. The remaining balance as of June 30, 1992, of
 19 unexpended appropriation in Capital Outlay shall be carried forward into
 20 fiscal year 1992-93 to be used for the same purpose for the next fiscal year.

21 SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
 22 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
 23 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
 24 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
 25 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
 26 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control
 27 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the
 28 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
 29 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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 31 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
 32 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
 33 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which
 34 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
 35 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
 36 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or

1 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
2 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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4 SECTION 6. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
5 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
6 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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8 SECTION 7. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
9 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
10 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
11 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
12 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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14 SECTION 8. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
15 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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17 SECTION 9. HEALTH PREMIUMS. The State Department for Social Security
18 Administration Disability Determination shall not, during the 1992-93 fiscal
19 year, spend more for health insurance per employee than the amount being
20 contributed to the State Employees Health Insurance Program.

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22 SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
23 Seventy-Eighth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of
24 Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year
25 period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1991 is essential to the
26 operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided,
27 and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the
28 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1991 could work irreparable harm
29 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
30 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
31 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
32 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1991.
