HOUSE BILL

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE ARKANSAS TOWING AND RECOVERY
10 BOARD FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1993; AND
11 FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

16 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES . There is hereby established for the
17 Arkansas Towing and Recovery Board for the 1991-93 biennium, the following
18 maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the
19 provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code
20 §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.
21 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary
22 is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said
23 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions
24 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular
25 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its
26 successor.

34 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS . There is hereby appropriated, to the
35 Arkansas Towing and Recovery Board, to be payable from cash funds as defined

1 by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the Arkansas Towing and Recovery Board, for
 2 Personal Services and Operating Expenses of the Arkansas Towing and Recovery
 3 Board for the biennial period ending June 30, 1993, the following:

18 SECTION 3. BOARD MEMBER EXPENSES. The Board is to be reimbursed for
 19 meals and lodging, and any other expenses necessary when conducting board
 20 business, as well as being reimbursed for mileage at the rate allowed for
 21 state employees. The Board Members will receive per diem at the rate of fifty
 22 dollars (\$50) for conducting board business.

24 SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
 25 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
 26 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
 27 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
 28 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
 29 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control
 30 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the
 31 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
 32 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

33

34 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
 35 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations

1 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which
2 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
3 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
4 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
5 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
6 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

8 SECTION 6. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
9 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
10 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

12 SECTION 7. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
13 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
14 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
15 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
16 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

17

18 SECTION 8. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
19 with this Act are hereby repealed.

20

21 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
22 Seventy-Eighth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of
23 Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year
24 period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1991 is essential to the
25 operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided,
26 and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the
27 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1991 could work irreparable harm
28 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
29 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
30 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
31 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1991.
