HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

7 FOR A JOINT SESSION OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND
8 SENATE AT 2:00 P.M., WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 23, IN THE HOUSE
9 CHAMBER TO HEAR AN ADDRESS BY THE HONORABLE PATRICK F.
10 TAYLOR, PRESIDENT OF TAYLOR ENERGY COMPANY.

13 WHEREAS, Mr. Patrick F. Taylor, President of Taylor Energy Company of
14 New Orleans, Louisiana, is primarily responsible for the enactment of
15 legislation in Louisiana to provide free college tuition to students who meet
16 specified academic standards, have no criminal record, and who meet other
17 specified criteria including financial need; and

18 WHEREAS, it is expected that some 1000 Louisiana students will attend
19 college under this program in the 1991 school year; and

20 WHEREAS, Mr. Taylor's ability to inspire high school students to stay in
21 school and to improve their academic achievements is legendary; and

22 WHEREAS, the Arkansas General Assembly is most fortunate to have an
23 opportunity to hear Mr. Taylor at a time when the state of Arkansas is engaged
24 in an all-out effort to improve public education and educational opportunities
25 for the young people of the state,

28 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-EIGHTH GENERAL
29 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:
