HOUSE RESOLUTION

7
8 REQUESTING THE ARKANSAS RACING COMMISSION TO REALLOCATE
9 RACING PASSES PROVIDED TO THE MEMBERS OF THE HOUSE OF
10 REPRESENTATIVES.

12 WHEREAS, the members of the House of Representatives are provided racing
13 passes for use by their constituents; and

14

15 WHEREAS, the present system puts an unfair burden on many members of the
16 House of Representatives because the demand for passes in their districts
17 exceed the number allocated to them; and

18

19 WHEREAS, there has been no reallocation of racing passes since 1981 and
20 House districts have been reapportioned; and

21

22 WHEREAS, the Arkansas Racing Commission should either provide the
23 members of the House of Representatives with a sufficient number of racing
24 passes for their constituents or racing passes should be abolished,

25

26 NOW THEREFORE,

27 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-EIGHTH GENERAL
28 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

29

30 That the Arkansas Racing Commission is requested to revise the
31 allocation of racing passes to members of the House of Representatives for the
32 1992 racing season in order to provide each member a sufficient number of
33 passes to meet the needs of their constituents.

34

35 BE FURTHER RESOLVED that the Arkansas Racing Commission is requested to

1 allocate racing passes based on the request made by members of the House of
2 Representatives on the form circulated and signed by members of the House of
3 Representatives on January 28, 1991.

4

5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Arkansas Racing Commission is requested
6 to consider this matter at a special or regular meeting of the commission and,
7 prior to a vote by the House of Representatives on any bill making an
8 appropriation for the Arkansas Racing Commission, to provide the House of
9 Representatives a signed declaration of what action the commission intends to
10 take concerning the allocation of racing passes to the members of the House of
11 Representatives.
