## **HOUSE RESOLUTION**

7  
8 REQUESTING THE UNIFORM PERSONNEL CLASSIFICATION AND  
9 COMPENSATION PLAN SUBCOMMITTEE OF THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
10 CONDUCT A STUDY OF THE SALARIES, EXPENSES AND BENEFITS OF  
11 PROSECUTING ATTORNEYS AND DEPUTY PROSECUTING ATTORNEYS.

13 WHEREAS, there continues to be a growing disparity between the salaries  
14 and benefits of prosecuting attorneys and those of circuit and chancery  
15 judges; and

16

17 WHEREAS, the salaries and benefits of deputy prosecuting attorneys  
18 differ greatly among the seventy-five (75) counties of Arkansas and have not  
19 kept pace with the increased duties imposed on deputy prosecuting attorneys in  
20 recent years; and

22 WHEREAS, a study of these salaries and benefits needs to be conducted in  
23 order for the General Assembly to act to establish some uniformity and equity,

25 NOW THEREFORE,

26 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-EIGHTH GENERAL  
27 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

29 THAT the Uniform Personnel Classification and Compensation Plan  
30 Subcommittee of the Legislative Council conduct a study of the salaries,  
31 expenses and benefits of prosecuting attorneys and deputy prosecuting  
32 attorneys in order that a recommendation may be made to the 79th General  
33 Assembly that will establish uniformity and equity with these salaries,  
34 expenses and benefits.
