HOUSE RESOLUTION

8 URGING SCHOOL DISTRICTS OF ARKANSAS TO ADOPT AND IMPLEMENT
9 PROCEDURES WHICH PROTECT THE PRIVACY RIGHTS OF STUDENTS
10 PARTICIPATING IN FREE AND REDUCED PRICE MEALS PROGRAMS.

13 WHEREAS, students in the public schools of this state which qualify for
14 free or reduced price meals should be encouraged to participate fully in such
15 program; and

16

17 WHEREAS, participation by a student is frequently perceived by the
18 student's peers as a negative reflection on the participating student,
19 resulting in the attachment of a poor social stigma and negative stereotyping;
20 and

22 WHEREAS, the children of this state are too frequently faced with
23 circumstances which lead to low self-esteem; and

25 WHEREAS, negative stereotyping and low self-esteem in the children of
26 this state is unacceptable in a free, democratic society which strives to
27 encourage improvement and betterment of all its citizens;

30 NOW THEREFORE,

31 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-EIGHTH GENERAL
32 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

34 THAT the school districts of this state are urged, with the technical
35 assistance provided by the State Department of Education, to devise, adopt and

1 implement procedures which protect the privacy rights of students
2 participating in the free or reduced price meal programs in the public schools
3 of this state.
