HOUSE RESOLUTION

8 HONORING THE AMERICAN TREE FARM SYSTEM ON THE CELEBRATION
9 OF ITS FIFTIETH ANNIVERSARY.

11 WHEREAS, the American Tree Farm System is largely responsible for the
12 reforestation of the United States; and

13 WHEREAS, the American Tree Farm System advocates the planting of both
14 hardwood and softwood; and

15 WHEREAS, the reforestation of America has enhanced the oxygen supply for
16 all mankind; and

17 WHEREAS, tree farming has enhanced the natural beauty of the State of
18 Arkansas; and

19 WHEREAS, the planting of trees aides in the fight against soil erosion;
20 and

21 WHEREAS, individuals, as well as corporate entities, are members of the
22 American Tree Farm System; and

23 WHEREAS, the American Tree Farm System has increased our awareness of
24 the environmental and economic benefits of tree farming;

26 NOW THEREFORE,

27 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-EIGHTH GENERAL
28 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

30 THAT the American Tree Farm System is hereby commended for its efforts
31 which have largely resulted in the reforestation of this country.

33 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon the adoption of this resolution, a copy
34 hereof be transmitted by the Chief Clerk of the House to the Arkansas Forestry
