7 **For An Act To Be Entitled**

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE §20-17-901 TO REQUIRE THE
9 COUNTY JUDGE OF EACH COUNTY IN ARKANSAS TO POST SIGNS AT
10 THE ENTRANCE OF ALL CEMETERIES WITHIN THE COUNTY WARNING
11 OF THE CRIMINAL PENALTIES FOR DEFACING OR DESECRAZING A
12 CEMETERY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

15

16 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 20-17-901 is hereby amended to read as
17 follows:

18 "(b) Registration required - Posting of warning signs.

19 (a) All cemeteries now existing in the state shall be registered with
20 the county judge, if under his jurisdiction, or with the mayor, as the case
21 may be, and a copy of the registration shall be filed with the Department of
22 Health. This registration shall show the location and boundaries of the
23 cemetery.

24 (b) The county judge of each county in the state shall be required to
25 post and maintain warning signs at the entrance of each cemetery within his
26 county. The signs shall warn that it constitutes a violation of the offense
27 of defacing objects of public respect, Arkansas Code §5-71-215, to deface,
28 mar, or desecrate a cemetery or burial monument. The signs shall further
29 state the possible penalties for violations of the law."

30

31 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of general and permanent nature
32 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
33 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

34

35 SECTION 3. Severability. In the event any provision of this act is

1 declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or
2 adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of this act which can be
3 given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision. The remaining
4 portions of this act shall remain in full force and effect as if the portion
5 declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of
6 the act.

7

8 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
9 hereby repealed.
