For An Act To Be Entitled

7 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE ANNOTATED §12-12-507(a)(3)
8 TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES TO NOTIFY
9 MANDATED REPORTERS OF SUSPECTED CHILD ABUSE OR NEGLECT OF
10 THEIR ACTIONS OR INTENDED ACTIONS; AND FOR OTHER
11 PURPOSES."

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

15 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Annotated §12-12-507(a)(3) is amended to read
16 as follows:

17 "(3) The investigation of each report of suspected abuse or neglect
18 shall begin within seventy-two (72) hours or within twenty-four (24) hours
19 after the initial report of child abuse, sexual abuse, or neglect required by
20 this subchapter which involves sexual abuse, or serious physical abuse
21 involving death, bone fractures, internal injuries, head injuries, burns,
22 immersions or suffocations, severe bruises, or abandonment, whereupon the
23 Department of Human Services shall notify and initiate an investigation in
24 cooperation with law enforcement agencies and the prosecuting attorney.
25 Immediately upon undertaking an investigation of suspected abuse or neglect by
26 the department, or within ten (10) days of receiving the report, whichever is
27 sooner, the department shall notify the person making the report in writing of
28 the department's actions or intended actions. If the person making the report
29 is a teacher or school official, the department notification shall become a
30 part of the child's confidential file maintained at the school."

32 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
33 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
34 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

2 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
3 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
4 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
5 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
6 act are declared to be severable.

8 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
9 hereby repealed.
