# A Bill

**SENATE BILL**

## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR TRANSFERS TO VARIOUS  
9 STATE AGENCIES FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND  
10 ADMINISTRATION - DISBURSING OFFICER FOR THE BIENNIAL  
11 PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1993; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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15 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the  
16 Department of Finance and Administration - Disbursing Officer, to be payable  
17 from the various state agencies' funds for the purpose of providing the  
18 various state agencies with a method of disbursing proceeds received from  
19 refunds, for the biennial period ending June 30, 1993, the following:

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26 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the  
27 Department of Finance and Administration - Disbursing Officer, to be payable  
28 from the various State Treasury Funds, fund accounts or accounts, for the  
29 purpose of providing various offices of the elected Constitutional Officers,  
30 including the Bureau of Legislative Research, the Division of Legislative  
31 Audit, and the Judicial Department with supplemental appropriations for  
32 payment of regular salaries for the biennial period ending June 30, 1993, the  
33 following:

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5 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the  
6 Department of Finance and Administration - Disbursing Officer, to be payable  
7 from the various State Treasury Funds, fund accounts or accounts, for the  
8 purpose of providing various State agencies with supplemental appropriation  
9 for payment of overtime compensation, personal services matching, and regular  
10 salaries for the biennial period ending June 30, 1993, the following:

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19 SECTION 4. TRANSFER PROVISIONS. The Department of Finance and  
20 Administration shall transfer appropriation as provided in Section 1 hereof in  
21 such amounts as funds are deposited into the State Treasury or financial  
22 institutions for proceeds received from insurance policies for casualty  
23 losses, overpayment of obligations, overpayment of salaries, over-allocation  
24 of federal assistance, maturity or redemption of investments, and subrogation  
25 payments received for workers' compensation claims paid, for the benefit of  
26 various state agencies. Provided, however, that the Chief Fiscal Officer of  
27 the State is hereby authorized to promulgate such rules, regulations,  
28 procedures, and guidelines as he may deem necessary and proper in order to  
29 carry out the provisions of this act.

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31 SECTION 5. CLASSIFICATION AND USE OF APPROPRIATIONS. The  
32 appropriations authorized in Section 1 hereof which are transferred to the  
33 various agencies as authorized by Section 4 hereof are to be used for the same  
34 purposes and shall be expended under the same provisions as cited in Arkansas  
35 ~~Code 19-4-501 through 19-4-525, the same being the General Accounting and~~

1 Budgetary Procedures Law of Arkansas, or its successor.

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3 SECTION 6. TRANSFER PROCEDURES - OVERTIME. In the event that there is  
 4 not sufficient appropriation provided for by the General Assembly for overtime  
 5 compensation pursuant to Arkansas Code 19-4-1612 for any state agency for the  
 6 biennial period ending June 30, 1993, said agency shall request a transfer  
 7 from appropriations provided by item (01) of Section 3 herein, from the Chief  
 8 Fiscal Officer of the State, stating clearly the amount required. Upon  
 9 approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, and after seeking prior  
 10 review by the Arkansas Legislative Council, the State Auditor shall be  
 11 notified as to the amount and the purposes for which said appropriation is to  
 12 be made. The appropriation shall be established upon the books of the  
 13 Department of Finance and Administration and the State Auditor. Provided,  
 14 further, that if desired, said appropriation shall be supplemental to those  
 15 regularly appropriated for such purposes by the General Assembly for that  
 16 agency.

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18 SECTION 7. TRANSFER PROCEDURES - MATCHING. In the event that there is  
 19 not sufficient appropriation, from funds deposited in the State Treasury,  
 20 provided for by the General Assembly for personal services matching for any  
 21 state agency for the biennial period ending June 30, 1993, said agency shall  
 22 request a transfer from appropriation provided by item (02) of Section 3  
 23 herein, from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, stating clearly the  
 24 amounts required for each item. Upon approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of  
 25 the State, the State Auditor shall be notified as to the amount and the  
 26 purposes for which said appropriation is to be made and shall be established  
 27 upon the books of the Department of Finance and Administration and the State  
 28 Auditor. Provided further, if desired, that said appropriation shall be  
 29 supplemental to those regularly appropriated for such purposes by the General  
 30 Assembly for that agency. Provided, however, that in the event the amount of  
 31 transfer requested exceeds One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000), the Chief Fiscal  
 32 Officer of the State shall seek prior review by the Arkansas Legislative  
 33 Council before said transfer shall be made.

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35 SECTION 8. TRANSFER OF APPROPRIATION - ELECTED OFFICERS. If it is

1 determined by any office of an elected Constitutional Officer, including the  
2 Bureau of Legislative Research, Division of Legislative Audit or the Judicial  
3 Department, that there is not sufficient appropriation for Regular Salaries to  
4 pay the maximum salaries which have been set by the General Assembly for the  
5 employees of such Office, the Director of the Office shall notify the Chief  
6 Fiscal Officer of the fact and the amount of appropriation which has been  
7 determined to be required. Upon receipt of such notification, and after  
8 seeking prior review by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, the  
9 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall transfer on his books the amount of  
10 appropriation required from the appropriation provided in Section 2 hereof to  
11 the Fund or Fund Account from which the Office's employees are paid and shall  
12 notify the State Auditor to process such transfer upon his books of record.

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14 SECTION 9. TRANSFER PROCEDURES - REGULAR SALARIES. In the event that  
15 there is not sufficient appropriation provided for by the General Assembly for  
16 payment of Regular Salaries for any state agency for the biennial period  
17 ending June 30, 1993, said agency may request a transfer from appropriations  
18 provided by item (03) of Section 3 herein, from the Chief Fiscal Officer of  
19 the State, stating clearly the amount required. Upon approval of the Chief  
20 Fiscal Officer of the State, and after seeking prior review by the Arkansas  
21 Legislative Council, the State Auditor shall be notified as to the amount and  
22 the purposes for which said appropriation is to be made. The appropriation  
23 shall then be established upon the books of the Department of Finance and  
24 Administration and the State Auditor. Provided further, that if desired, said  
25 appropriation shall be supplemental to those regularly appropriated for such  
26 purposes by the General Assembly for the agency.

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28 SECTION 10. RESTRICTIONS. Nothing in this Act is to be construed as an  
29 authority to transfer a like amount of current general revenues to fund  
30 appropriations provided for in this Act.

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32 SECTION 11. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
33 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
34 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
35 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and

1 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
2 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control  
3 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the  
4 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
5 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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7       SECTION 12. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
8 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
9 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which  
10 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
11 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
12 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
13 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
14 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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16       SECTION 13. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and  
17 permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and  
18 the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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20       SECTION 14. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the  
21 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such  
22 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which  
23 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this  
24 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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26       SECTION 15. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict  
27 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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29       SECTION 16. HEALTH PREMIUMS. The Department of Finance and  
30 Administration - Disbursing Officer shall not, during the 1992-93 fiscal year,  
31 spend more for health insurance per employee than the amount being contributed  
32 to the State Employees Health Insurance Program.

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34       SECTION 17. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
35 Seventy-Eighth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of

1 Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year  
2 period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1991 is essential to the  
3 operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided,  
4 and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the  
5 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1991 could work irreparable harm  
6 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
7 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
8 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
9 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1991.

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
