## For An Act To Be Entitled

7 "AN ACT TO AMEND THE ARKANSAS WATER AND AIR POLLUTION  
8 CONTROL ACT, CODIFIED AT TITLE 8, CHAPTER 1 OF THE  
9 ARKANSAS CODE ANNOTATED, TO REMOVE THE ANNUAL AIR PERMIT  
10 FEE LIMIT FOR EMISSIONS FROM MAJOR SOURCES AND TO CHANGE  
11 THE LANGUAGE TO COMPLY WITH THE FEDERAL CLEAN AIR ACT  
12 AMENDMENTS OF 1990 IN ORDER TO RECEIVE THE NECESSARY  
13 FUNDING FOR COSTS OF OPERATING THE STATE AIR PROGRAM, AND  
14 AMEND ALL LANGUAGE WHERE NECESSARY IN THE ACT TO REFLECT  
15 COMPLIANCE WITH THE FEDERAL CLEAN AIR ACT REGARDING AIR  
16 PERMIT AND EMISSION FEES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Annotated §8-1-103 (2)(B)(ii) is hereby  
22 amended to read as follows:

23 "(ii) The annual review and inspection fee and the modification fee  
24 shall not exceed one thousand dollars (\$1,000) for minor source air code  
25 permits, water permits or solid waste permits per category of permit per  
26 facility. All annual fees for air permits issued under the State  
27 Implementation Plan and/or the regulations promulgated pursuant to the Federal  
28 Clean Air Act shall be assessed in accordance with the Federal Clean Air Act."

29

30 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
31 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
32 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

33

34 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
35 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect

1 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
2 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
3 act are declared to be severable.

5 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
6 hereby repealed.
