# A Bill

**SENATE BILL 409**

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## For An Act To Be Entitled

7 "AN ACT TO CREATE THE ARKANSAS ATHLETICS AND ACTIVITIES  
8 BOARD; TO CREATE THE OFFICE OF ATHLETICS AND ACTIVITIES  
9 WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION; AND FOR OTHER  
10 PURPOSES."

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13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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15 SECTION 1. PURPOSE. It is the purpose of this act to bring athletics  
16 and other activities of public schools within the supervision of the State  
17 Board of Education and the Department of Education. The General Assembly  
18 finds that state supervision is desirable in order to bring athletics and  
19 academics closer together and to provide a better forum for public input on  
20 decisions concerning athletic programs.

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22 SECTION 2. For the purpose of this act:

23 (1) "Activity or activities" shall not include religious activities of  
24 private schools;

25 (2) "Board" means the Arkansas Athletics and Activities Board created  
26 by this act; and

27 (3) "School" means each public school district and any private school  
28 electing to be covered by this act.

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30 SECTION 3. *The State Board of Education shall divide the state into  
31 twenty-one (21) activity districts for the purpose of the selection of members  
32 representing activity districts to the Arkansas Athletics and Activities Board  
33 created in this act. Each activity district shall consist of substantially  
34 the same number of schools.*

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1        SECTION 4. (a) There is created the Arkansas Athletics and Activities  
2 Board. The board shall be composed of twenty-four (24) members as follows:

3                (1) One (1) board member shall be selected from each of the  
4 twenty-one (21) activity districts and shall be elected by a majority vote of  
5 the public schools and participating private schools in the district. Each  
6 public school and each participating private school shall designate one (1)  
7 administrator of the school to represent the school in the selection of a  
8 board member from the activity district.

9                (2) Three (3) board members shall be selected from the state at-  
10 large and shall be appointed by the Governor and shall be members of a racial  
11 minority group.

12                (b) Except for at-large members, members of the board shall reside  
13 within the activity district from which selected and shall be an administrator  
14 of a school in the activity district. At-large members shall be residents of  
15 the State of Arkansas and shall be an administrator of a school in Arkansas.

16                (c) Members shall serve for three (3) year terms. However, the terms  
17 of the initial members shall be determined by the members by lot in such a  
18 manner as to provide for eight (8) members serving for a term of one (1) year,  
19 eight (8) members serving for a term of two (2) years and eight (8) members  
20 serving a term of three (3) years.

21                (d) A member may serve for a maximum of two (2) consecutive terms.

22                (e) The members of the board, by majority vote, shall annually select  
23 from the membership a chairman and such other officers as the board deems  
24 appropriate.

25                (f) A vacancy on the board shall be filled for the unexpired term by  
26 the method of selection provided for the vacant member and shall be filled by  
27 a person with the same qualifications as the vacant member.

28                (g) Members of the board shall serve without compensation but shall be  
29 entitled to mileage and per diem at the rate provided for state employees.  
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31        SECTION 5. (a) Beginning with the 1992-93 school year, the board shall  
32 regulate all athletic activities and other extracurricular activities of  
33 public schools in this state and the activities of any private school which  
34 elects to be included under the provisions of this act. A private school may  
35 elect to be included for the purpose of all activities or may elect to be  
36 included for the purpose of one or more athletic activities or extracurricular

1 activities.

2         (b) The board shall adopt regulations concerning the conduct of  
3 activities. The regulations shall include but shall not be limited to the  
4 following:

- 5                 (1) the sanctioning of events;  
6                 (2) eligibility rules for students;  
7                 (3) athletic conference alignments;  
8                 (4) the conduct of athletic tournaments; and  
9                 (5) matters pertaining to contest or event referees and officials  
10 for athletic or extracurricular activities.

11         (c) All rules and regulations of the board shall be promulgated  
12 pursuant to the *Administrative Procedure Act*. Before any rule or regulation  
13 becomes effective, it must be approved at an annual meeting of school  
14 administrators. Each school shall designate one (1) administrator to  
15 represent the school at the annual meeting. Rules and regulations approved at  
16 the annual meeting shall become effective the next school year.

17         (d) For the purpose of defraying the cost of administering this act,  
18 the board may adopt reasonable fees to be paid by participating schools. The  
19 fees shall not become effective until approved by the State Board of  
20 Education.

21         (e) Any final decision of the board may be appealed to the State Board  
22 of Education.

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24         SECTION 6. There is created within the Department of Education an  
25 office to be known as the "Office of Athletics and Activities". The director  
26 and other employees of the office shall be employees of the Department of  
27 Education.

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29         SECTION 7. (a) There is created a temporary advisory committee to be  
30 known as the "Advisory Committee on Athletics and Activities." It shall be  
31 the duty of the committee to advise the State Board of Education concerning  
32 the formation of activity districts and to conduct the initial election for  
33 the members representing activity districts to the Arkansas Athletics and  
34 Activities Board. The committee shall cease to exist upon the election of the  
35 initial members representing activity districts to the Arkansas Athletics and

## 1 Activities Board.

2               (b) The committee shall be composed of seven (7) regular members and  
3 two (2) ex officio members.

4 (c) The seven (7) members shall be appointed as follows:

12 Assembly shall appoint one (1) member of the House of Representatives to serve  
13 as an ex officio member. The President Pro Tempore of the Senate shall  
14 appoint one member of the Senate to serve as an ex officio member of the  
15 committee.

16               (e) Members of the committee shall serve without compensation but shall  
17 be entitled to mileage and *per diem* at the rate provided for state employees.

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19 SECTION 8. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
20 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
21 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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23 SECTION 9. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
24 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
25 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
26 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
27 act are declared to be severable.

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29 SECTION 10. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
30 hereby repealed.
