For An Act To Be Entitled

7 "AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE ANY PHYSICIAN PRACTICING MEDICINE IN
8 A FEDERALLY CERTIFIED RURAL HEALTH *CLINIC* TO PREESTABLISH
9 AND APPROVE A PROTOCOL OF TREATMENT FOR PATIENTS INCLUDING
10 THE PRESCRIBING OF MEDICINE FOR SUCH TREATMENT AND MAY
11 EXTEND TO ANY LICENSED PHYSICIAN'S TRAINED ASSISTANT OR
12 LICENSED NURSE PRACTITIONER UNDER HIS OR HER SUPERVISION
13 THE PRIVILEGE OF WRITING PRESCRIPTIONS FOR SUCH MEDICINE;
14 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

18 SECTION 1. Any licensed physician practicing medicine in any federally
19 certified rural health *clinic* located in a *health professional shortage area*
20 as defined in 42 U.S.C. Sec. 254e, as amended (Public Health Services Act) in
21 the State that is certified by the Arkansas Department of Health is hereby
22 authorized to preestablish and approve a protocol of treatment for patients in
23 the *clinic*, including the prescription of medicines for such treatment and may
24 extend to any Arkansas licensed physician's trained assistant or Arkansas
25 licensed nurse practitioner under his or her supervision the privilege of
26 writing prescriptions for such medicines with the exception of controlled
27 substances as designated in Ark. Code Ann. §5-64-101 et seq. When any such
28 licensed physician has extended to a physician's trained assistant or nurse
29 practitioner the privilege of writing prescriptions for medicines for the
30 treatment of the physician's patients as authorized herein, any pharmacist is
31 authorized to fill such prescriptions.

33 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
34 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code

1 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

2

3 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
4 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
5 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
6 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
7 act are declared to be severable.

8

9 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
10 hereby repealed
