# A Bill

**SENATE BILL**

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## 7 **For An Act To Be Entitled**

8 "AN ACT TO REAPPROPRIATE THE BALANCES OF CAPITAL  
9 IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF ARKANSAS  
10 HERITAGE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

11

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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14 SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION. There is hereby appropriated, to the  
15 Department of Arkansas Heritage - Central Administration, to be payable from  
16 the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the  
17 Department of Arkansas Heritage - Central Administration, the following:

18 (A) Effective July 1, 1991, the balance of the appropriation provided  
19 in Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 154 of the First Extraordinary Session of  
20 1989, for acquisition, renovation, site preparation, and other related  
21 expenses of the Delta Cultural Center, in a sum not to exceed ..... \$50,000.

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23 SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION - COMMEMORATIVE COMMISSION. There is hereby  
24 appropriated, to the Department of Arkansas Heritage - Commemorative  
25 Commission, to be payable from the cash funds as defined by Arkansas Code 19-  
26 4-801 of the Department of Arkansas Heritage - Commemorative Commission, the  
27 following:

28 (A) Effective June 30, 1991, the balance of the appropriation provided  
29 in Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 20 of the First Extraordinary Session of 1989,  
30 for major maintenance, renovation, repair, and exhibit replacement for the Old  
31 State House, in a sum not to exceed ..... \$30,000.

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33 SECTION 3. REAPPROPRIATION - COMMEMORATIVE COMMISSION. There is hereby  
34 appropriated, to the Department of Arkansas Heritage - Commemorative  
35 Commission, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor

1 fund or fund accounts, for the Department of Arkansas Heritage - Commemorative  
2 Commission, the following:

3           (A) Effective July 1, 1991, the balance of the appropriation provided  
4 in Item (C) of Section 2 of Act 20 of the First Extraordinary Session of 1989,  
5 for major maintenance, renovation, site improvements and repairs, and Old  
6 State House exhibit replacement, in a sum not to exceed ..... \$188,775.  
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8           (B) Effective July 1, 1991, the balance of the appropriation provided  
9 in Item (B) of Section 2 of Act 20 of the First Extraordinary Session of 1989,  
10 for major maintenance, renovation, repair and exhibit replacement, in a sum  
11 not to exceed ..... \$140,519.

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13           SECTION 4. REAPPROPRIATION - NATURAL HERITAGE COMMISSION. There is  
14 hereby appropriated, to the Department of Arkansas Heritage - Natural Heritage  
15 Commission, to be payable from the federal funds as designated by the Chief  
16 Fiscal Officer of the State, for the Department of Arkansas Heritage - Natural  
17 Heritage Commission, the following:

18           (A) Effective July 1, 1991, the balance of the appropriation provided  
19 in Item (B) of Section 3 of Act 240 of the First Extraordinary Session of  
20 1989, for natural area acquisition and development for the Natural Heritage  
21 Commission, in a sum not to exceed ..... \$124,132.

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23           SECTION 5. REAPPROPRIATION - TERRITORIAL CAPITAL RESTORATION. There is  
24 hereby appropriated, to the Department of Arkansas Heritage - Territorial  
25 Capitol Restoration, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its  
26 successor fund or fund accounts, for the Department of Arkansas Heritage -  
27 Territorial Capitol Restoration, the following:

28           (A) Effective July 1, 1991, the balance of the appropriation provided  
29 in Item (A) of Section 3 of Act 20 of the First Extraordinary Session of 1989,  
30 for major maintenance, repairs and renovation, in a sum not to exceed. \$3,117.

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32           SECTION 6. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor  
33 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects  
34 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available  
35 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and

1 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and  
2 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or  
3 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State  
4 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects  
5 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds  
6 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General  
7 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall  
8 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this Act.

9           (B) Any restrictions contained in the Acts enumerated in the  
10 reappropriation sections of this Act, the restrictions of any applicable  
11 provisions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary  
12 Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal  
13 control laws of this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of  
14 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied  
15 with in disbursement of any funds provided by this Act unless specifically  
16 provided otherwise by law.

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18           SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
19 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
20 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which  
21 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
22 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
23 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
24 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
25 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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27           SECTION 8. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent  
28 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
29 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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31           SECTION 9. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the  
32 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such  
33 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which  
34 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this  
35 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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2        SECTION 10. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict  
3 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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5        SECTION 11. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
6 Seventy-Eighth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of  
7 Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year  
8 period; that previous General Assemblies have provided appropriations for the  
9 projects provided enumerated in this act; that certain appropriations will  
10 expire before the adjournment of the General Assembly; and that if such  
11 appropriations expire, the projects and programs authorized herein will cease  
12 thereby depriving the citizens of the State of the benefits to be derived from  
13 such projects. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this  
14 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health  
15 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its  
16 passage and approval.

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
