# A Bill

**SENATE BILL**

## **For An Act To Be Entitled**

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE ANNOTATED § 27-16-901(b) TO  
9 ALLOW FOR RENEWAL OF DRIVERS LICENSE BY MAIL IF THE  
10 APPLICANT HAS NO MOVING VIOLATIONS IN THE PRECEDING THREE  
11 (3) YEARS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

12  
13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

14  
15 SECTION 1. Section 27-16-901(b) of the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated  
16 is hereby amended to read as follows:

17 "(b) (1) Every driver's license shall be renewable on or before its  
18 expiration upon completion of an application, payment of the fees designated  
19 in §27-16-801, and passage of the eyesight test required in §27-16-704 and  
20 shall be renewed without other examination, unless the Commissioner has reason  
21 to believe that the licensee is no longer qualified to receive a license.

22 (2) However, if the applicant successfully passed the eyesight test  
23 for the license or application period immediately preceding, the Department  
24 may waive the requirement of an eyesight test provided the applicant renews by  
25 mail and has no moving violations during the past three (3) years and is under  
26 the age of sixty-five (65) and over the age of twenty-one (21)."

27  
28 SECTION 2. The Director of the Department of Finance and Administration  
29 is authorized to promulgate rules and regulations as shall be deemed necessary  
30 or desirable for effectively carrying out the intent and purpose of this Act.

31  
32 SECTION 3. The provisions of this Act shall be in full force  
33 and effect on and after January 1, 1992.

34  
35 SECTION 4. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature

1 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
2 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

4       SECTION 5. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
5 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
6 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
7 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
8 act are declared to be severable.

10       SECTION 6. All laws or parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
11 hereby repealed.
