## For An Act To Be Entitled

7 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE § 20-63-104 TO INCREASE THE  
8 ANNUAL LICENSE FEE FOR RETAILERS OF CONTRACEPTIVE DEVICES  
9 FROM ONE DOLLAR (\$1.00) TO FIVE DOLLARS (\$5.00) PER YEAR;  
10 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

15 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 20-63-104 is hereby amended to read as  
16 follows:

17 "20-63-104. Licenses - Issuance and fees.

18 (a) All licenses shall be issued by the Arkansas State Board of  
19 Pharmacy on written application and payment of an annual license fee of  
20 twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) for each wholesale license and five dollars  
21 (\$5.00) for each retail license. Each licensee shall obtain as many licenses,  
22 and pay the fee prescribed in this section for each license, required where  
23 the sales are to be made from more than one (1) store or salesroom.

24 (b) The license shall be in effect for one (1) year from January 1 of  
25 each year.

26 (c) All license fees, and the share of all fines paid to the board  
27 pursuant to this section, shall be retained and used by the board in the  
28 carrying out and enforcement of this chapter, except as provided in  
29 20-63-101."

30

31 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of general and permanent nature  
32 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
33 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

34

35 SECTION 3. If any provisions of this act or the application thereof to

1 any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect  
2 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
3 the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
4 act are declared to be severable.

5

6 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
7 hereby repealed.
