## 7 **For An Act To Be Entitled**

8 "AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE HOME BUILDERS STUDY COMMISSION;  
9 TO PROVIDE FOR THE COMPLETION OF THE COMMISSION'S DUTIES  
10 UPON THE FILING OF ITS REPORT WITH THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY;  
11 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

14

15 SECTION 1. (a) There is established the Home Builders Study  
16 Commission. The Commission shall be composed of two (2) Senators appointed by  
17 the Senate Pro Tempore, two (2) members of the House of Representatives  
18 appointed by the Speaker of the House, and four (4) members appointed by the  
19 Governor. Two (2) of the members appointed by the Governor shall be engaged  
20 in the home building industry and the other two (2) members appointed by the  
21 Governor shall be appointed at large.

22 (b) The Governor shall appoint the chairman of the commission.

23

24 SECTION 2. (a) It shall be the duty of the Commission to:

25 (1) study the requirements of various municipalities for the  
26 licensure and regulation of home builders;

27 (2) study state laws having an impact on the home building  
28 industry; and

29 (3) determine the need for state or local licensing and regulation  
30 of the home building industry.

31 (b) The Commission shall make its findings and recommendations along  
32 with any proposed legislation no later than the convening of the next regular  
33 session of the General Assembly at which time the Commission will expire.

34

35 SECTION 3. The Commission shall expire upon the filing of its report

1 with the General Assembly.

3 SECTION 4. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
4 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
5 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

6

7 SECTION 5. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
8 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
9 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
10 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
11 act are declared to be severable.

12

13 SECTION 6. All laws or parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
14 hereby repealed.
