## **SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION**

7 REQUESTING THE JOINT INTERIM COMMITTEE ON STATE AGENCIES  
8 AND GOVERNMENTAL AFFAIRS TO CONDUCT A STUDY OF THE  
9 FEASIBILITY OF ESTABLISHING A COMPUTERIZED STATE-WIDE  
10 VOTER REGISTRATION SYSTEM.

12 WHEREAS, voter registration lists are maintained on the county level and  
13 the state does not have a centralized listing of all registered voters; and

14 WHEREAS, the lack of a state-wide list hampers the administration of the  
15 election laws; and

16 WHEREAS, a state-wide computerized list of registered voters would  
17 assist the Secretary of State in verifying the sufficiency of initiative and  
18 referendum petitions,

20 NOW THEREFORE,

21 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE SEVENTY-EIGHTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE  
22 STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

24 That the Joint Interim Committee on State Agencies and Governmental  
25 Affairs is requested to conduct an interim study of the feasibility and cost  
26 of establishing a computerized system for maintaining a state-wide voter  
27 registration list. The committee is requested to make its findings and  
28 recommendations to the Seventy-Ninth General Assembly.
