7 **SENATE MEMORIAL RESOLUTION**

8 IN RESPECTFUL MEMORY OF U. S. ARMY CORPORAL J. SCOTT  
9 LINDSEY.

11 WHEREAS, J. Scott Lindsey, 27, a Corporal attached to the 418th Infantry  
12 Battalion, 3rd Armored Division, U.S. VII Corps was killed March 1, 1991  
13 during OPERATION DESERT STORM near the Iraq-Kuwait border; and

14 WHEREAS, Corporal Scott was buried at Fayetteville's National Cemetery  
15 which dates back to the Civil War and his marker will be the first engraved  
16 "Persian Gulf"; and

17 WHEREAS, the Arkansas State Senate also extends condolences to his  
18 parents, retired Air Force Major Joe Lindsey and Beatrice Lindsey of  
19 Springdale; his wife, Debra; his son and two daughters.
