## **SENATE RESOLUTION**

8 REQUESTING THE JOINT INTERIM COMMITTEE ON AGRICULTURE AND  
9 ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT TO CONDUCT A STUDY OF THE FEASIBILITY  
10 AND DESIRABILITY OF INSTITUTING AN AMNESTY PROGRAM FOR THE  
11 DISPOSAL OF AGRICULTURAL CHEMICALS WHICH ARE NO LONGER  
12 LAWFUL.

16 NOW THEREFORE,

17 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE SEVENTY-EIGHTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE  
18 STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 That the Joint Interim Committee on Agriculture and Economic Development  
21 is hereby requested to conduct a study of the feasibility and desirability of  
22 instituting an amnesty program within this State which would allow for the  
23 proper disposal of agricultural chemicals which are now unlawful without  
24 penalizing the persons in possession of such chemicals.

26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Joint Interim Committee on Agriculture and  
27 Economic Development recommends appropriate legislation to the General  
28 Assembly at the next regular session for the purpose of funding and  
29 implementing such program if the same is determined to be feasible and  
30 desirable.
