HOUSE BILL

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 10-3-901(a) TO PRESCRIBE
9 THE METHOD OF SELECTION OF MEMBERS OF THE JOINT
10 PERFORMANCE REVIEW COMMITTEE AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE
11 SELECTION OF A HOUSE VICE CHAIRMAN AND A SENATE VICE
12 CHAIRMAN OF THE COMMITTEE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

16 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 10-3-901(a) is hereby amended to read as
17 follows:

18 "(a) There is hereby created the 'Joint Performance Review Committee'
19 which shall consist of twenty (20) members of the House of Representatives to
20 be appointed by the Speaker of the House and seven (7) members of the Senate
21 to be appointed by the Senate Committee on Committees. Provided, once the
22 House membership of the Committee is appointed and in place, the Speaker shall
23 make appointments to the committee only to fill vacancies occurring in the
24 House membership of the committee. There shall be a Senate cochairman and a
25 House cochairman and a Senate Vice Chairman and a House Vice Chairman of the
26 committee. The highest ranking House member of the committee shall be the
27 House cochairman of the committee and the second highest ranking House member
28 on the committee shall be the House vice chairman of the committee."

30 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
31 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
32 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

34 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
35 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect

1 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
2 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
3 act are declared to be severable.

5 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
6 hereby repealed.
