SENATE BILL

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE ARKANSAS SENATE WHICH SHALL BE
10 SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS APPROPRIATED
11 BY ACT 2 OF 1991 AND ACT 30 OF 1991, FOR THE REMAINDER OF
12 THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1993; AND FOR OTHER
13 PURPOSES."

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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17 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the
18 Arkansas Senate, to be payable from the Constitutional Officers Fund, for
19 personal services and operating expenses of the Arkansas Senate which shall be
20 supplemental and in addition to those funds appropriated in Section 1 of Act 2
21 of 1991, for the remainder of the biennial period ending June 30, 1993, the
22 following:

26 (1) Mileage Allowance, Per Diem, Salaries of Employees,
27 Employer Matching Funds, Maintenance and General
28 Operations and other expenses as authorized by
29 law, the sum of \$75,000.00
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31 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the
32 Arkansas Senate, to be payable from the State Central Services Fund, for
33 personal services of the Arkansas Senate which shall be supplemental and in
34 addition to those funds appropriated in Section 2 of Act 30 of 1991, for the
35 remainder of the biennial period June 30, 1993, the following:

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8 SECTION 3. The Arkansas Senate is hereby authorized the position of
9 Assistant to the Secretary of the Senate at a maximum annual salary rate of
10 \$24,318 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992 and \$25,533 for the fiscal
11 year ending June 30, 1993. The Assistant to the Secretary of the Senate shall
12 be under the direction of the Secretary of the Senate. The amount of salary
13 to be paid to the Assistant to the Secretary of the Senate shall be determined
14 by the Senate Efficiency Committee.

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16 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
17 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
18 in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this Act
19 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
20 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
21 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
22 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint
23 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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25 SECTION 5. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
26 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
27 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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29 SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the application
30 thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall
31 not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given
32 effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the
33 provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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35 SECTION 7. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with

1 this Act are hereby repealed.

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3 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
4 Seventy-Eighth General Assembly meeting in Extraordinary Session, that funds
5 provided by the Seventy-Eighth General Assembly for the operations of the
6 Arkansas Senate are, due to unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for the
7 Arkansas Senate to continue to provide essential governmental services; that
8 the provisions of this act will provide the necessary monies for the Arkansas
9 Senate to continue such services; and that a delay in the effective date of
10 this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and
11 provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is
12 hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate
13 preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and
14 effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.

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
