SENATE BILL 14

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For An Act To Be Entitled

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8 "AN ACT TO CREATE A PILOT PROGRAM WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF
9 HIGHER EDUCATION TO BE KNOWN AS THE "CENTER FOR WORKFORCE
10 EXCELLENCE."

11

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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14 SECTION 1. For the purpose of this Act:

15 (1) "Center" means the Center for Workforce Excellence; and
16 (2) "Department" means the Department of Higher Education.

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18 SECTION 2. (a) There is created in the Department of Higher Education
19 the "Center for Workforce Excellence" which shall conduct a pilot project to
20 assist industrial development through the coordination of training programs
21 and services.

22 (b) The pilot project shall be a cooperative effort among the
23 Department of Higher Education, Arkansas Industrial Development Commission,
24 Henderson State University, Ouachita Technical College, Arkadelphia High
25 School, Malvern High School, private industry, and other appropriate groups.

26 (c) Local industrial groups, local governmental units, and private
27 enterprise should provide much of the financial support needed for the pilot
28 project. Such support should include financial support for items such as
29 office space, expenses, and utilities.

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31 SECTION 3. (a) The goals of the Center shall be to:

32 (1) Facilitate the development of students and workers, members of
33 the "learning force" within Arkansas communities and companies, with a focus
34 on workers' skills and workplace tools of the future, particularly high level
35 technical training and education.

5 (b) The Center shall develop a strategic management plan to include
6 initial industry services training, with a survey of existing facilities,
7 opportunities for training with the potential project area, and development of
8 a campaign plan to overcome training deficiencies in the areas through
9 reliance on existing resources through the cooperation and development of new
10 training capability through innovative low cost means.

11 (c) The Center shall assist private industry in determining what
12 training services and programs are available, the steps necessary to provide
13 the training services and programs needed by the industry, and how long it
14 would take to develop the needed training services and programs.

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16 SECTION 4. (a) The Department of Higher Education shall establish a
17 local advisory committee to provide guidance to the Center in implementing the
18 pilot project. The local advisory committee shall include representatives of
19 the Department of Higher Education, Arkansas Industrial Development
20 Commission, Henderson State University, Ouachita Technical College,
21 Arkadelphia High School, Malvern High School, and private industry. The
22 Department may include representatives of other appropriate groups and
23 organizations.

24 (b) The purpose or the local advisory committee shall be to assist the
25 Center in determining the proper focus for industrial development.

26 (c) The local advisory committee shall make recommendations concerning:

27 (1) "soft skills" interpersonal relationships, such as discipline
28 and self reliance and an ability to communicate properly;

33 (4) other issues concerning the training and development of
34 students and workers.

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36 SECTION 5. The Department of Higher Education shall establish

1 regulations governing the operation of the Center.

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3 SECTION 6. The Department of Higher Education may, as it deems
4 appropriate, establish additional pilot projects for workforce excellence in
5 other areas of the state. Each pilot project shall be established in
6 cooperation with institutions of education, private industry and other
7 appropriate groups in the area to be served. For each new pilot project the
8 Department of Higher Education shall establish a local advisory committee
9 which shall include representatives of institutions of education, private
10 industry and other appropriate groups. The duties of the local advisory
11 committee shall be the same as those provided in Section 4 of this act.

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13 SECTION 7. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
14 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
15 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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17 SECTION 8. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
18 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
19 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
20 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
21 act are declared to be severable.

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23 SECTION 9. All laws or parts of laws in conflict with this act are
24 hereby repealed.

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26 SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
27 Seventy-Eighth General Assembly, meeting in Extraordinary Session, that in
28 order to attract high technology industry to this state that a highly trained
29 workforce is essential; and that the provisions of this act will provide
30 necessary resources for such workforce. Therefore, an emergency is hereby
31 declared to exist and this act being necessary for the immediate preservation
32 of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from
33 and after its passage and approval.
