## 7 **For An Act To Be Entitled**

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION TO PAY THE SALARIES AND  
9 EXPENSES OF THE GOVERNOR'S LEGISLATIVE LIAISON AND  
10 LEGISLATIVE CLERKS; DURING THE FIRST EXTRAORDINARY SESSION  
11 OF THE SEVENTY-EIGHTH ARKANSAS GENERAL ASSEMBLY; AND FOR  
12 OTHER PURPOSES."

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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16 SECTION 1. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Office  
17 of the Governor - Legislative Liaison Staff for the fiscal year ending June  
18 30, 1992, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to  
19 be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such  
20 purposes on a weekly basis:

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27 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the  
28 Governor's Office, to be payable from the Constitutional Officers Fund, for  
29 personal services and operating expenses for the Office of the Governor -  
30 Legislative Liaison Staff for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992, the  
31 following:

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5       SECTION 3. The Governor is hereby authorized to employ one (1)  
6 Legislative Liaison who shall serve without pay but shall be entitled to per  
7 diem of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for each day the General Assembly is in  
8 special session. After receiving approval of the Governor, the Department of  
9 Finance and Administration - Management Services Division is hereby authorized  
10 to process payments to said Liaison from funds authorized by this Act.

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12       SECTION 4. PAYMENT OF SALARIES AND PER DIEM. Salaries and per diem as  
13 authorized in Sections 1 and 3 of this Act shall be in effect from and after  
14 February 24, 1992.

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16       SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
17 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
18 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
19 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and  
20 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
21 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control  
22 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the  
23 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
24 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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26       SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
27 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
28 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which  
29 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
30 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
31 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
32 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
33 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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35       SECTION 7. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent

1 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
2 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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4 SECTION 8. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the  
5 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such  
6 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which  
7 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this  
8 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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10 SECTION 9. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict  
11 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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13 SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
14 Seventy-Eighth General Assembly meeting in First Extraordinary Session, that  
15 monies were not provided by the Seventy-Eighth General Assembly to pay the  
16 salaries and expenses of the Legislative Liaison and Clerks needed by the  
17 Governor to effectively carry out the duties of this office, that the services  
18 so provided are essential to provide effective coordination between the  
19 Governor's Office and the General Assembly; that the provisions of this Act  
20 will provide the necessary monies for such salaries and expenses; and that  
21 delay in the effective date of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the  
22 proper administration and provision for essential governmental services.  
23 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
24 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
25 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and  
26 approval.

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
