SENATE BILL

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE ARKANSAS SENATE WHICH SHALL BE
10 SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS APPROPRIATED
11 BY ACT 2 OF 1991, ACT 30 OF 1991, AND ACT 1 OF THE FIRST
12 EXTRAORDINARY SESSION OF 1992 FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE
13 BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1993; AND FOR OTHER
14 PURPOSES."

Subtitle

17 "SENATE EXTRAORDINARY SESSION APPROPRIATION."

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the
22 Arkansas Senate, to be payable from the Constitutional Officers Fund, for
23 personal services and operating expenses of the Arkansas Senate which shall be
24 supplemental and in addition to those funds appropriated in Section 1 of Act 2
25 of 1991 and Act 1 of the First Extraordinary Session of 1992, for the
26 remainder of the biennial period ending June 30, 1993, the following:

30 (1) Mileage Allowance, Per Diem, Salaries of Employees,
31 Employer Matching Funds, Maintenance and General
32 Operations and other expenses as authorized by
33 law, the sum of \$75,000.00

35 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the

1 Arkansas Senate, to be payable from the State Central Services Fund, for
2 personal services of the Arkansas Senate which shall be supplemental and in
3 addition to those funds appropriated in Section 2 of Act 30 of 1991, for the
4 remainder of the biennial period June 30, 1993, the following:

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12 SECTION 3. The Arkansas Senate is hereby authorized the position of
13 Assistant to the President Pro Tempore of the Senate at a maximum annual
14 salary rate of \$25,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1993. The
15 Assistant to the President Pro Tempore shall be under the direction of the
16 President Pro Tempore of the Senate. The amount of salary to be paid to the
17 Assistant to the President Pro Tempore of the Senate shall be determined by
18 the Senate Efficiency Committee.

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20 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
21 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
22 in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this Act
23 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
24 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
25 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
26 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint
27 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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29 SECTION 5. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
30 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
31 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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33 SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the application
34 thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall
35 not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given

1 effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the
2 provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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4 SECTION 7. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with
5 this Act are hereby repealed.

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7 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
8 Seventy-Eighth General Assembly meeting in Extraordinary Session, that funds
9 provided by the Seventy-Eighth General Assembly for the operations of the
10 Arkansas Senate are, due to unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for the
11 Arkansas Senate to continue to provide essential governmental services; that
12 the provisions of this act will provide the necessary monies for the Arkansas
13 Senate to continue such services; and that a delay in the effective date of
14 this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and
15 provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is
16 hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate
17 preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and
18 effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.

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
