7 **SENATE RESOLUTION**

8 COMMENDING SENATOR CLARENCE E. BELL FOR HIS LIFETIME OF
9 DISTINGUISHED PUBLIC SERVICE.

12 WHEREAS, Senator Clarence E. Bell of Parkin, who has devoted what most
13 would consider a lifetime--36 years--to the Arkansas Senate, is retiring from
14 public office December 31, 1992; and

16 WHEREAS, Senator Clarence Bell, affectionately called "Coach" and "Mr.
17 Education", has served his native State of Arkansas with great distinction and
18 honor, following a gifted career in athletics and public education; and

20 WHEREAS, Senator Clarence Bell has risen to the top of service in the
21 Arkansas General Assembly, claiming the Number One position in seniority,
22 chairing key committees, and earning the reputation as the General Assembly's
23 leading spokesman on education; and

25 WHEREAS, Senator Clarence Bell leaves the Arkansas Senate not only with
26 a remarkable record of public service, but with the understanding of all who
27 were privileged to have worked with him that he touched the lives of thousands
28 of people in a positive, genuine, loving, "grandfatherly" fashion heretofore
29 unmatched in the history of the Arkansas Senate.
