## For An Act To Be Entitled

8  
9 "AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTION  
10 COMMISSIONERS IN EACH COUNTY TO GIVE NOTICE OF ELECTION  
11 PRECINCT LOCATIONS NO LATER THAN FIVE (5) CALENDAR DAYS  
12 BEFORE EACH PRIMARY ELECTION AND EACH GENERAL ELECTION;  
13 AND TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 7-5-101 TO REQUIRE POSTING AT  
14 PREVIOUS POLLING SITES A NOTICE INDICATING ANY CHANGES  
15 MADE IN THE POLLING SITES SINCE THE LAST ELECTION; AND FOR  
16 OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

19 "AN ACT TO REQUIRE A COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTION  
20 COMMISSIONERS TO GIVE NOTICE OF PRECINCT LOCATIONS NO  
21 LATER THAN FIVE (5) CALENDAR DAYS BEFORE EACH PRIMARY  
22 ELECTION AND EACH GENERAL ELECTION."

24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

25

26 SECTION 1. (a) No later than five (5) calendar days before each  
27 election, the county board of election commissioners of each county in this  
28 state shall give notice of election precinct locations by means reasonably  
29 calculated to reach the registered voters in the county.

30 (b) This section does not apply to run-off elections.

31

32 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
33 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
34 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

35

1           SECTION 3. Subsection (d) of Arkansas Code 7-5-101 is amended to read  
2 as follows:

3           "(d) Notice of any changes made in polling sites shall also be given to  
4 the electors by posting information about any such changes prominently at all  
5 previous polling sites which were used in the last election."

6

7           SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
8 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
9 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
10 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
11 act are declared to be severable.

12

13           SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
14 hereby repealed.
