# **A Bill**

**HOUSE BILL**

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## **For An Act To Be Entitled**

8 "AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH, DIVISION OF  
9 VITAL RECORDS, TO PROVIDE NOTIFICATION OF THE DEATH OF ANY  
10 COUNTY RESIDENT TO THE COUNTY AND CIRCUIT COURT CLERKS  
11 WITHIN THIRTY (30) CALENDAR DAYS AFTER THE DEATH  
12 CERTIFICATE IS FILED."

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## **Subtitle**

15 "TO REQUIRE THE DIVISION OF VITAL RECORDS TO PROVIDE  
16 NOTIFICATION OF THE DEATH OF ANY COUNTY RESIDENT TO COUNTY  
17 AND CIRCUIT COURT CLERKS."

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19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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21 SECTION 1. Within thirty (30) calendar days after a death certificate  
22 is filed pursuant to Arkansas Code 20-18-601, the Department of Health,  
23 Division of Vital Statistics, shall provide notification of the death to the  
24 county and circuit court clerks in the county where the deceased was a  
25 resident.

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27 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
28 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
29 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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31 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
32 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
33 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
34 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
35 act are declared to be severable.

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SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
