## 7 **For An Act To Be Entitled**

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE ANNOTATED § 6-13-616 TO  
9 PROVIDE THAT NO EMPLOYEE OF A SCHOOL DISTRICT SHALL BE  
10 ELIGIBLE TO SERVE ON THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE  
11 EMPLOYING SCHOOL DISTRICT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## 13 **Subtitle**

14 "TO PROVIDE THAT NO SCHOOL DISTRICT EMPLOYEE SHALL BE  
15 ELIGIBLE TO SERVE ON THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE  
16 EMPLOYING SCHOOL DISTRICT."

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19

20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-13-616 is hereby amended to read as  
21 follows:

22 "6-13-616. Qualifications of directors [As to 1989 amendment and  
23 repeal, see A.C.R.C. Notes.]

24 (a) Except as provided in subsection (c) of this section, no person  
25 shall be eligible to be a member of any school district board of directors in  
26 this state unless he is a bona fide resident and qualified elector of the  
27 school district which he serves.

28 (b) No person who is elected to a school district board of directors  
29 shall be eligible for employment in that same school district.

30 (c) (1) A person whose residential property contains portions of two (2)  
31 school districts shall be eligible to be a member of either of the school  
32 district's board of directors provided he is a qualified elector of the county  
33 in which the school district for which he seeks the position lies and he has  
34 or formerly had children enrolled in that school district.

35 (2) For purposes of this subsection, residential property means

1 that parcel of land which contains the dwelling in which the person resides  
2 not less than nine (9) months out of each year."

3

4 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
5 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
6 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

7

8 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
9 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
10 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
11 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
12 act are declared to be severable.

13

14 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
15 hereby repealed.
