HOUSE BILL

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE ANNOTATED § 6-11-102 TO
9 REQUIRE THAT THE DIRECTOR OF GENERAL EDUCATION SHALL SERVE
10 AT THE PLEASURE OF THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION AND THAT
11 THE DIRECTOR OF VOCATIONAL AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION SHALL
12 SERVE AT THE PLEASURE OF THE STATE BOARD OF VOCATIONAL
13 EDUCATION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

16 "TO REQUIRE THAT THE DIRECTORS OF GENERAL AND VOCATIONAL &
17 TECHNICAL EDUCATION SHALL SERVE AT THE PLEASURE OF THEIR
18 RESPECTIVE BOARDS."

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Annotated § 6-11-102(a) is hereby amended to
23 read as follows:

24 "(a) The State Board of Education is empowered to employ a person to
25 act as the Director of General Education, who shall serve at the pleasure of
26 the board, and the State Board of Vocational Education is empowered to employ
27 a person to act as the Director of Vocational and Technical Education, who
28 shall serve at the pleasure of the board."

30 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Annotated § 6-11-102(d) and (e) is hereby
31 amended to read as follows:

32 "(d) It is the specific intention of this act to define and declare the
33 Director of General Education to be an employee of the State Board of
34 Education and the Director of Vocational and Technical Education to be an
35 employee of the State Board of Vocational Education, and no other

1 interpretation shall be given to this section.

2 (e) (1) The Director of General Education or a disbursing agent
3 designated by him and approved by the State Board of Education and the
4 Director of Vocational and Technical Education or a disbursing agent
5 designated by him and approved by the State Board of Vocational Education
6 shall give bond to the State of Arkansas as provided by law for other
7 disbursing agents, conditioned for the faithful performance of their duties
8 and the faithful accounting for all the school money of the state, of any
9 county, or of any school district that may come into their hands.

10 (2) The bond shall be in a solvent surety company having a right
11 to do business in the State of Arkansas and shall be approved by the State
12 Board of Education and the State Board of Vocational Education.

13 (3) The premium on the bond shall be paid by the State Board of
14 Education and the State Board of Vocational Education as a board expense."

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16 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
17 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
18 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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20 SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
21 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
22 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
23 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
24 act are declared to be severable.

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26 SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
27 hereby repealed.

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29 SECTION 6. This act shall become effective July 1, 1994.

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
