16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

18 *SECTION 1. Persons hereafter employed by, contracted with, or appointed
19 by the Department of Pollution Control and Ecology to perform on-farm
20 inspections must successfully complete forty (40) hours of training covering
21 the principles of agricultural production, agricultural engineering, farm
22 financial management, and wildlife and environmental biology within one (1)
23 year of the date of their appointment as an on-farm inspector. Such persons
24 shall maintain and upgrade their knowledge of farm operations by completing
25 three (3) continuing education units (CEU's) within two (2) years of the date
26 of their initial training and three (3) CEU's every two (2) years thereafter
27 to be administered through the University of Arkansas Continuing Education
28 system. Training shall be provided under the auspices of the Cooperative
29 Extension Service.*

31 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
32 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
33 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
