## 6 **For An Act To Be Entitled**

7 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE § 24-3-102 TO CHANGE THE  
8 DEFINITION OF FINAL AVERAGE PAY TO APPLY TO THE HIGHEST  
9 FOUR (4) YEARS OF COMPENSATION; TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE §  
10 24-3-201 TO CHANGE THE PROVISIONS DEALING WITH TEMPORARY  
11 ANNUITIES; AND TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE § 24-4-101 TO CHANGE  
12 THE DEFINITION OF AVERAGE COMPENSATION TO INCLUDE THE  
13 HIGHEST FOUR (4) YEARS OF COMPENSATION; AND FOR OTHER  
14 PURPOSES."

## 16 **Subtitle**

17 "AN ACT TO CHANGE THE DEFINITIONS OF FINAL AVERAGE PAY  
18 AND AVERAGE COMPENSATION UNDER PERS LAW TO APPLY TO THE  
19 HIGHEST 4 YEARS OF SALARY."

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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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23 SECTION 1. Subdivision (8) of Arkansas Code § 24-3-102 is hereby  
24 amended to read as follows:

25 "(A) Final average pay for members of the Arkansas Public  
26 Employees Retirement System means the average of the highest annual  
27 compensations paid a member during any period of forty-eight (48) calendar  
28 months of credited service with a public employer. Should a member have less  
29 than forty-eight (48) calendar months of credited service, final average pay  
30 means the monthly average of pay to him during his total years of credited  
31 service. Any other provision to the contrary notwithstanding, if a member's  
32 rate of pay is set by the Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 70, § 1, then the  
33 member's final average pay shall not be less than his monthly rate of pay at  
34 time of separation from covered employment; and

35 (B) Final average pay for members of the Arkansas State Police

1 Retirement System means the average of the highest annual compensations paid a  
2 member during any period of sixty (60) calendar months of credited service  
3 with the Arkansas State Police. Should a member have less than sixty (60)  
4 calendar months of credited service, final average pay means the monthly  
5 average of pay to him during his total years of credited service;"  
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7 SECTION 2. Subsection (e) of Arkansas Code § 24-3-201 is hereby amended  
8 to read as follows:

9 "(e) (1) Upon a member's retirement, he shall receive an annuity for  
10 life equal to the total of the following amounts: For each year of credited  
11 service resulting from employment in a position covered at any time by social  
12 security or another federal retirement plan supported wholly or in part by  
13 employer contributions, one and fifty-five hundredths percent (1.55%) of his  
14 final average pay plus, for each year of credited service resulting from  
15 employment in a position never so covered, one and eight hundred seventy-two  
16 thousandths percent (1.872%) of his final average pay. For a member of the  
17 General Assembly, a monthly annuity equal to thirty-five dollars (\$35.00)  
18 times the number of years of actual service as a member of the General  
19 Assembly. For a member of the General Assembly who served as Speaker of the  
20 House of Representatives or President Pro Tempore of the Senate, a monthly  
21 annuity equal to forty dollars (\$40.00) times the total number of years of  
22 actual service as a member of the General Assembly.

23 (2) In addition, if a member has credited service resulting from  
24 employment in a position covered at any time by social security or another  
25 federal retirement plan supported wholly or in part by employer contributions,  
26 and if that member is retiring as provided in subsections (a)-(d) of this  
27 section or § 24-3-207(a), and if that member's age at retirement is younger  
28 than:

29 (A) Social security's minimum age for an immediate  
30 retirement benefit; and

31 (B) Age sixty-two (62), then that member shall receive a  
32 temporary annuity equal to three hundred twenty-two thousandths percent  
33 (0.322%) of his final average pay for each year of such credited service.

34 (3) The temporary annuity shall terminate at the end of the  
35 calendar month in which the earliest of the following events occurs:

11                         (5) It is considered sound public policy that retirement pay not  
12 exceed working pay, except for increases after retirement caused by inflation;  
13 accordingly, at time of retirement, the total of named plan annuities  
14 resulting from employment in a position also covered by social security shall  
15 not exceed his final average pay."

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17 SECTION 3. Subdivision (17) of Arkansas Code § 24-4-101 is hereby  
18 amended to read as follows:

19         "(17) (A) (i) Average compensation means the average of the highest  
20 annual compensations paid a member during any period of four (4) years of  
21 credited service with a public employer.

22 (ii) Such four-year average shall be the greatest of the  
23 following:

24 (a) One-fourth (1/4) of the following: The total of  
25 highest compensations paid during the three (3) completed fiscal years when  
26 added to the total fourth highest compensation paid during the completed  
27 fiscal year; or

28 (b) One-fourth (1/4) of the following: The total of  
29 highest compensations paid during the three (3) completed fiscal years added  
30 to the total of the compensation paid for the months of credited service  
31 within the incomplete fiscal year in which the member retires, provided there  
32 are some, and the total fourth highest compensation paid during the completed  
33 fiscal year which has been multiplied by the number of months remaining in the  
34 fiscal year in which retirement occurs and divided by twelve (12);

35 (iii) Should said member have less than four (4) years of

1 credited service, average compensation means the annual average  
2 compensations to him during his total years of credited service.

3 (B) Any other provision to the contrary notwithstanding:

4 (i) If a member's rate of pay is set by Arkansas

5 Constitution, Amendment 70, Section 1, then the member's average  
6 compensation \_ shall not be less than his rate of pay at the time of separation  
7 from covered employment;

(ii) If a member's rate of pay is set by Arkansas

11 (iii) If a member served at any time in an office whose

(iii) If a member served at any time in an office whose

12 rate of pay is set by Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 70, Section 1, and that  
13 member was a member of the General Assembly on December 31, 1978, then the  
14 member's average compensation shall not be less than the rate of pay  
15 currently set for the highest legislative office the member held;"

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17 SECTION 4. All provisions of this act of general and permanent nature  
18 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
19 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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21 SECTION 5. If any provisions of this act or the application thereof to  
22 any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect  
23 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
24 the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
25 act are declared to be severable.

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27 SECTION 6. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
28 hereby repealed.
