## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 17, CHAPTER 33, SUBCHAPTER 3 OF THE  
9 ARKANSAS CODE OF 1987, ANNOTATED TO ADD A NEW SECTION TO  
10 PROVIDE FOR RECIPROCITY FOR SECURITY SERVICES CONTRACTORS,  
11 PRIVATE INVESTIGATORS, AND ALARM SYSTEM COMPANIES LICENSED  
12 IN OTHER STATES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

### Subtitle

14  
15 "AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR RECIPROCITY FOR SECURITY SERVICES  
16 CONTRACTORS, PRIVATE INVESTIGATORS, AND ALARM SYSTEM  
17 COMPANIES LICENSED IN OTHER STATES."

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20

21 SECTION 1. Title 17, Chapter 33, Subchapter 3 of the Arkansas Code of  
22 1987, Annotated is hereby amended to add a new Section 17-33-353 to read as  
23 follows:

24 "17-33-353. Reciprocity.

25 Any person who is licensed under the laws of another state or territory  
26 of the United States as a security services contractor, private investigator,  
27 or alarm systems company may apply for a license in this state upon production  
28 of satisfactory proof that:

29 (1) The other state or territory grants similar reciprocity to  
30 license holders of this state;

31 (2) The requirements for licensing in the particular state or  
32 territory were at the date of the applicant's licensing substantially  
33 equivalent to the requirements now in effect in this state;

34 (3) The applicant meets all the qualifications for the particular  
35 license of Arkansas Code § 17-33-306 and pays the fees specified for the

1 particular license in Arkansas Code § 17-33-209; and

2                   (4) The applicant meets other reasonable qualifications as may be  
3 adopted by the board for reciprocity."

4

5                 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of general and permanent nature  
6 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
7 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

8

9                 SECTION 3. If any provisions of this act or the application thereof to  
10 any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect  
11 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
12 the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
13 act are declared to be severable.

14

15                 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
16 hereby repealed.
