8 "AN ACT TO DEFINE THE TERM PHYSICIAN AS USED IN THE
9 GOOD SAMARITAN LAW AND OTHER LAWS OF ARKANSAS; AND FOR
10 OTHER PURPOSES."

12 **Subtitle**

13 "DEFINING THE TERM PHYSICIAN."

14

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

16

17 SECTION 1. For the purposes of Arkansas Code 17-93-101, the "Good
18 *Samaritan*" law, and any other law of this state which takes effect on or after
19 January 1, 1994, the term "physician" shall mean a person licensed by the
20 Arkansas State Medical Board, the Arkansas State Board of Chiropractic
21 Examiners, or the Arkansas Podiatry Examining Board.

22

23 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
24 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
25 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

26

27 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
28 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
29 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
30 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
31 act are declared to be severable.

33 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
34 hereby repealed.
