7 **For An Act To Be Entitled**

8 "AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR VESTING IN THE ARKANSAS STATE
9 HIGHWAY EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT SYSTEM; TO DECLARE AN
10 EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

12 **Subtitle**

13 "*AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR VESTING IN THE ARKANSAS STATE HIGHWAY*
14 *EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT SYSTEM.*"

15

16 *BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:*

17

18 *SECTION 1.* (a) Any employee of the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department who is a member of the
19 Arkansas State Highway Employees Retirement System and who has served as a member of the Arkansas Highway Commission shall receive
20 partial credit, equal to forty percent (40%) of the time the member served as a member of the Arkansas Highway Commission as "creditable
21 service".

22 (b) For the purpose of calculating the members annuity, the portion of "creditable service" attributed to serving on the Commission
23 shall not be considered when determining retirement eligibility nor shall it be considered when calculating the annuity, but is to be considered only
24 toward vesting in the Arkansas State Highway Employees Retirement System.

26 *SECTION 2.* All provisions of this act of general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987
27 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

28

29 *SECTION 3.* If any provisions of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity
30 shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end
31 the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

32

33 *SECTION 4.* All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.

35 *SECTION 5.* Emergency. It is hereby found and determined by the Seventy-Ninth General Assembly of the State of Arkansas

1 that the service rendered on the Arkansas Highway Commission by many people has not been adequately rewarded for many years, that to not
2 reward these services with vesting will create an inequity for all eligible employees, and that the effective and efficient administration of the
3 state government demands that this inequity be corrected immediately. Therefore, in order to correct this inequity, an emergency is hereby
4 declared to exist, and this act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, shall be in full force and
5 effect from and after its passage and approval.
