# A Bill

**HOUSE BILL**

## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND  
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE STATE DEPARTMENT FOR SOCIAL  
10 SECURITY ADMINISTRATION DISABILITY DETERMINATION FOR THE  
11 BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1995; AND FOR OTHER  
12 PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

14 "AN ACT FOR THE STATE DEPARTMENT FOR SOCIAL SECURITY  
15 ADMINISTRATION DISABILITY DETERMINATION APPROPRIATION."  
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18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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20 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the State  
21 Department for Social Security Administration Disability Determination for the  
22 1993-95 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees whose  
23 salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and  
24 Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all  
25 laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a  
26 specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt  
27 from the provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All  
28 persons occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the  
29 provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas  
30 Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

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3 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the State  
4 Department for Social Security Administration Disability Determination for the  
5 1993-95 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary  
6 employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein  
7 for such purposes: ten (10) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at  
8 rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and  
9 Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate  
10 classification.

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12 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the State  
13 Department for Social Security Administration Disability Determination, to be  
14 payable from the federal funds as designated by the Chief Fiscal Officer of  
15 the State, for personal services and operating expenses of the State  
16 Department for Social Security Administration Disability Determination for the  
17 biennial period ending June 30, 1995, the following:

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34 SECTION 4. CARRY FORWARD. The remaining balance as of June 30, 1994,  
35 of unexpended appropriation in Capital Outlay shall be carried forward into

1 fiscal year 1994-95 to be used for the same purpose for the next fiscal year.

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3 SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized  
4 by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds  
5 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the  
6 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary  
7 Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures  
8 and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of  
9 this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of  
10 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied  
11 with in disbursement of said funds.

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13 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
14 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
15 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which  
16 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
17 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
18 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
19 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
20 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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22 SECTION 7. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent  
23 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
24 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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26 SECTION 8. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the  
27 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such  
28 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which  
29 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this  
30 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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32 SECTION 9. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict  
33 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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35 SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the

1 Seventy-Ninth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas  
2 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that  
3 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1993 is essential to the operation of  
4 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
5 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective  
6 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1993 could work irreparable harm upon the  
7 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.  
8 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
9 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
10 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1993.

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
