## 7 **For An Act To Be Entitled**

8 "AN ACT TO DEFINE AND PROVIDE A REMEDY FOR CERTAIN ACTS OF  
9 MISREPRESENTATION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

### 11 **Subtitle**

12 "AN ACT TO DEFINE AND PROVIDE A REMEDY FOR CERTAIN ACTS OF  
13 MISREPRESENTATION."

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

16

17 SECTION 1. (a) In the event of a misrepresentation by a person to  
18 another person over the purchase or sale of consumer goods, the injured person  
19 shall be entitled to sue the perpetrator in Circuit or Small Claims Court.

20 The statue of limitation for this offense shall be three (3) years. The  
21 offense shall be a tortious act and venue shall lie in either the residence of  
22 the injured party; the place where the act causing the injury took place; or,  
23 the residence of the perpetrator, at the discretion of the plaintiff.

24 (b) Misrepresentation shall be defined as the making of a  
25 representation that the perpetrator knows is false, the making of a  
26 representation which the perpetrator does not have sufficient information to  
27 make, or the failure or omission to provide or disclose information about the  
28 consumer good which would be reasonably necessary to the injured person in  
29 arriving at a decision as to whether to make the transaction.

30 (c) Upon due proof, the injured party shall be entitled to compensatory  
31 damages and may also seek punitive damages.

32 (d) Any title or bill of sale executed and transferred in connection  
33 with the sale or purchase of a consumer good shall contain a disclosure of any  
34 known damage the subject good has had.

35

1 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
2 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
3 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

4

5 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
6 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
7 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
8 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
9 act are declared to be severable.

10

11 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
12 hereby repealed.
