7 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 3-6-104 TO PROVIDE THAT
8 NATIVE BRANDY MANUFACTURERS MAY SELL NATIVE BRANDY AT
9 RETAIL ON THE MANUFACTURERS_ PREMISES; AND FOR OTHER
10 PURPOSES."

Subtitle

12 "PROVIDE THAT NATIVE BRANDY MANUFACTURERS MAY SELL NATIVE
13 BRANDY AT RETAIL ON THE MANUFACTURERS_ PREMISES."

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

16

17 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 3-6-104(h) is amended to read as follows:
18 "(h) The holder of a permit shall be authorized to manufacture the
19 products defined in §3-6-102 and to sell them, without the necessity of
20 obtaining any further license or permit, to the holders of bona fide wholesale
21 or retail liquor permits issued in the manner now provided by law and may sell
22 the products to the holders of permits to manufacture native wines in this
23 state. Manufacturer shall be authorized to sell such products at retail on
24 the premises of the authorized place of manufacture."

26 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
27 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
28 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

29

30 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
31 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
32 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
33 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this

1 act are declared to be severable.

3 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
4 hereby repealed.
