11 PURPOSES."

## 13 **Subtitle**

14 "TO PERMIT NATIVE WINERIES AND LICENSED WINE AND *SPIRITS*  
15 *WHOLESALERS* TO CONDUCT WINE TASTINGS FOR EDUCATIONAL AND  
16 PROMOTIONAL PURPOSES."

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19

20 SECTION 1. *Native wineries and licensed and wine spirits wholesalers*  
21 *shall, upon prior approval by the Alcoholic Beverage Control Division, be*  
22 *allowed to conduct wine tasting events for educational and promotional*  
23 *purposes at any location in this state provided that written notice is given*  
24 *to the Alcoholic Beverage Control Division at least five (5) days prior to the*  
25 *event. Request for approval to conduct wine tasting events must be received*  
26 *by the Alcoholic Beverage Control Division at least two (2) weeks prior to the*  
27 *event.*

28

29 SECTION 2. *No wine tasting event may be held pursuant to this act in*  
30 *any facility licensed by the Alcoholic Beverage Control Division.*

31

32 SECTION 3. *The criminal penalties for drinking in public as prescribed*  
33 *by Arkansas Code 5-71-212(c) are not applicable to any wine tasting event*  
34 *approved by the Alcoholic Beverage Control Division pursuant to this act.*
