**HOUSE BILL**

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## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION TO THE OFFICE OF THE  
9 TREASURER OF STATE FOR PLANNING, DEVELOPING, AND  
10 IMPLEMENTING A NEW DATA PROCESSING SYSTEM; AND FOR OTHER  
11 PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

14 "AN ACT FOR THE OFFICE OF THE TREASURER OF STATE CAPITAL  
15 IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATION."

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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19 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS . There is hereby appropriated, to the Office  
20 of the Treasurer of State, to be payable from the State Central Services Fund,  
21 the following:

22 (A) For planning, developing, and implementing a new data processing  
23 system, the sum of ..... \$907,953.

25 SECTION 2. REGULAR SALARIES . There is hereby established for the  
26 Office of the Treasurer of State for the 1993-95 biennium, the following  
27 maximum number of additional regular employees whose salaries shall be  
28 governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act  
29 (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory  
30 thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum  
31 annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the  
32 provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons  
33 occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of  
34 the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-

1 101), or its successor.

10 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS . There is hereby appropriated, to the Office  
11 of the Treasurer of State, to be payable from the State Central Services Fund,  
12 for personal services of the Office of the Treasurer of State for the biennial  
13 period ending June 30, 1995, the following:

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21 SECTION 4. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor  
22 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects  
23 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available  
24 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and  
25 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and  
26 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or  
27 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State  
28 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects  
29 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds  
30 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General  
31 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall  
32 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this Act.

33 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State  
34 Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the  
35 Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this

1 State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and  
2 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in  
3 disbursement of any funds provided by this Act unless specifically provided  
4 otherwise by law.

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6 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
7 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
8 in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this Act  
9 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
10 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
11 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
12 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint  
13 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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15 SECTION 6. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent  
16 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
17 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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19 SECTION 7. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the application  
20 thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall  
21 not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given  
22 effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the  
23 provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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25 SECTION 8. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with  
26 this Act are hereby repealed.

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28 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
29 Seventy-Ninth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas  
30 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that  
31 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1993 is essential to the operation of  
32 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
33 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective  
34 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1993 could work irreparable harm upon the  
35 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.

1 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
2 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
3 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1993.
