## For An Act To Be Entitled

7 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND  
8 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF ARKANSAS HERITAGE  
9 - COMMEMORATIVE COMMISSION WHICH SHALL BE SUPPLEMENTAL AND  
10 IN ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS APPROPRIATED BY ACT 1065 OF  
11 1991, FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING  
12 JUNE 30, 1993; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

15 "AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF ARKANSAS HERITAGE -  
16 COMMEMORATIVE COMMISSION SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION."

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20

21 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the  
22 Department of Arkansas Heritage - Commemorative Commission for the remainder  
23 of the 1991-93 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees  
24 which shall be supplemental and in addition to those positions authorized in  
25 Section 17 of Act 1065 of 1991 and whose salaries shall be governed by the  
26 provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code  
27 §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.

28 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary  
29 is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said  
30 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions  
31 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular  
32 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its  
33 successor.

7 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the  
8 Department of Arkansas Heritage - Commemorative Commission, to be payable from  
9 the Department of Arkansas Heritage Fund Account, for personal services and  
10 operating expenses of the Department of Arkansas Heritage - Commemorative  
11 Commission which shall be supplemental and in addition to those funds  
12 appropriated in Section 19 of Act 1065 of 1991, for the remainder of the  
13 biennial period ending June 30, 1993, the following:

29 SECTION 3. FUNDING TRANSFER. Immediately upon the effective date of  
30 this Act, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall transfer on his books  
31 and those of the State Treasurer the sum of ninety one thousand nine hundred  
32 eighty six dollars (\$91,986) from the General Revenue Allotment Reserve Fund  
33 to the Department of Arkansas Heritage Fund Account to provide funds for the  
34 appropriation provided herein.

1           SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
2 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
3 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
4 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and  
5 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
6 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control  
7 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the  
8 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
9 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

11           SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
12 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
13 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which  
14 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
15 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
16 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
17 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
18 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

20           SECTION 6. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent  
21 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
22 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

23

24           SECTION 7. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the  
25 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such  
26 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which  
27 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this  
28 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

29

30           SECTION 8. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict  
31 with this Act are hereby repealed.

32

33           SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
34 Seventy-Ninth General Assembly meeting in Regular Session, that funds provided  
35 by the Seventy-Eighth General Assembly for the operations of the Department of

1 Arkansas Heritage - Commemorative Commission are, due to unforeseen  
2 circumstances, insufficient for the Department of Arkansas Heritage -  
3 Commemorative Commission to continue to provide essential governmental  
4 services; that the provisions of this act will provide the necessary monies  
5 for the Department of Arkansas Heritage - Commemorative Commission to continue  
6 such services; and that a delay in the effective date of this Act could work  
7 irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential  
8 governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist  
9 and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public  
10 peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the  
11 date of its passage and approval.
