**HOUSE BILL 1912**

## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES,  
9 OPERATING EXPENSES AND GRANTS FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF HIGHER  
10 EDUCATION FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1995;  
11 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

14 "AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF HIGHER EDUCATION  
15 APPROPRIATION."

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - GENERAL OPERATIONS. There is hereby  
20 established for the Department of Higher Education - General Operations for  
21 the 1993-95 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees whose  
22 salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and  
23 Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all  
24 laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a  
25 specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt  
26 from the provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All  
27 persons occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the  
28 provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas  
29 Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

24 SECTION 18. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the

25 Department of Higher Education, to be payable from the Higher Education

26 Building Maintenance Fund, for maintenance of various buildings at the

27 institutions of higher education by the Department of Higher Education for the

28 ~~biennial period ending June 30, 1995, the sum of.....\$26,000,000.~~

29

30 SECTION 19. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the

31 Department of Higher Education, to be payable from the Higher Education

32 Research Development Fund, for providing Arkansas Research Development Program

33 Grants to Institutions of Higher Education, for the biennial period ending

34 June 30, 1995, the sum of .....\$10,000,000.

35

1 SECTION 20. REPORTING REQUIREMENTS. The reports of college achievement  
2 of high school graduates, as appropriated in Section 9 herein, shall be  
3 provided to high school and school district administrators and may also be  
4 provided to the State Board of Higher Education, the Governor, the Joint  
5 Interim Committee on Education, the Board of Education and the Department of  
6 Education, as designated by the Department of Higher Education.

7

8 SECTION 21. TRANSFER PROVISION. Upon certification by the Director of  
9 the Department of Higher Education that transfers are needed to make maximum  
10 utilization of funds and appropriations provided for financial aid programs,  
11 and with the approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and a review by  
12 the Arkansas Legislative Council, funds and appropriations may be transferred  
13 between financial aid programs.

14

15 SECTION 22. TRANSFER PROVISION. Upon certification by the Chairman of  
16 the State Board of Higher Education to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State,  
17 funds and appropriation provided in Section 7 of this Act may be transferred  
18 to Institutions of Higher Education as deemed appropriate by the State Board  
19 of Higher Education. Upon filing of any required plan by an Institution of  
20 Higher Education to the State Board of Higher Education, such plan shall be  
21 filed with the Arkansas Legislative Council for its review.

22

23 SECTION 23. In order to provide timely payments under financial aid  
24 appropriations made in this Act, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State is  
25 authorized to provide loans from the Budget Stabilization Trust Fund to make  
26 available all funds attributable to the financial aid programs under the then  
27 current official revenue estimates. In the event of an unanticipated state  
28 revenue shortfall, any such loans remaining at the end of a fiscal year shall  
29 be repaid from revenues distributed in the first two months of the next fiscal  
30 year. Funds for appropriations made in this Act for purposes other than  
31 financial aid shall not be affected by the application of this provision.

32

33 SECTION 24. CARRY FORWARD. The unexpended balances of funding  
34 authorized in Section 5 of this Act, General Operations, for capital outlay  
35 that pertain to the completion of the acquisition of a new agency computer

1 system, that remains on June 30, 1993, shall be carried forward for the same  
2 purposes for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1994, and the unexpended balances  
3 of the funding and appropriation that remain on June 30, 1994, shall be  
4 carried forward for the same purposes for the fiscal year ending June 30,  
5 1995.

6  
7 SECTION 25. APPROPRIATION AND FUND TRANSFERS. The following amounts of  
8 appropriation and funding may be transferred by the Department of Higher  
9 Education, from the appropriation made in Item (11) of Section 10 of this Act,  
10 to those Institutions of Higher Education and programs as enumerated below:

7 SECTION 26. On June 30, 1997, after the initial transition period and  
8 accreditation has been achieved for the various technical colleges, ten (10)  
9 of the positions authorized in Section 32 of Act 1101 of 1991 for the purpose  
10 of providing personnel resources necessary to implement the technical college  
11 legislation enacted by the Seventy-Eighth General Assembly will be deleted  
12 from the Department's appropriation.

13

14 SECTION 27. The unexpended balances of the appropriations and funding  
15 authorized in Section 6 of this Act as of June 30, 1994, shall be carried  
16 forward and made available for the purpose of continuing the technical  
17 education implementation/restructuring through the fiscal year ending June 30,  
18 1995.

19

20 SECTION 28. The Department of Higher Education is hereby authorized to  
21 utilize the appropriations and funds authorized by this Act for minority  
22 scholarships for the payment of "paid internships" as may be authorized by  
23 "The Minority Teacher Recruitment and Training Program."

24

25 SECTION 29. After the amounts to be made available to the various  
26 technical colleges have been determined by the State Board of Higher Education  
27 under the provisions of Act 1244 of 1991 and Act 1246 of 1991, and upon the  
28 review and approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, such documents  
29 as may be necessary shall be processed so that funds may be transferred from  
30 the Work Force 2000 Development Fund to the State Treasury fund or fund  
31 account from which the technical college draws is general revenue support. Be  
32 it further provided that such funds as may be transferred shall not exceed  
33 73.24% of the total funds available from the Work Force 2000 Development Fund  
34 during each fiscal year of the biennial period ending June 30, 1995.

35

1 SECTION 30. In order to promote efficiency in the utilization of  
2 educational resources and to maximize the availability of funds for student  
3 scholarships in the state, such funds as may remain at the end of each fiscal  
4 year for Academic Challenge Scholarships as provided for in Arkansas Code §6-  
5 82-1001 et. seq., may be transferred to and made available for, student  
6 assistance grants under the State Scholarship Program as provided in Arkansas  
7 Code §6-82-201 et seq. Upon certification by the Director of the Department  
8 of Higher Education that transfer of funds is needed to maximize the  
9 utilization of funds provided for state scholarship grants and with the  
10 approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and a review by the Arkansas  
11 Legislative Council, funds may be transferred between Academic Challenge  
12 Scholarships and State Scholarship Grants.

13

14 SECTION 31. After the sum of \$13,200,000 has been deposited into the  
15 Higher Education Building Maintenance Fund, the next \$10,000,000 or so much as  
16 is collected, is to be transferred to the Research Development Fund there to  
17 be used as provided by law.

18

19 SECTION 32. REFUND TO EXPENDITURES. Proceeds derived from the  
20 repayment of loans as authorized in Item (03) of Section 10 of this act for  
21 the Math/Science Teacher Loan Awards Program shall be deposited into the State  
22 Treasury as "Refunds to Expenditures."

23

24 SECTION 33. CARRY FORWARD. *The balance of the funds and appropriations*  
25 *as provided in Section 10 of this Act for the Academic Challenge Scholarships*  
26 *Program which remain on June 30, 1994, shall be carried forward and made*  
27 *available for the same purpose for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995.*

28

29 SECTION 34. *In the event that the appropriations as authorized in Items*  
30 *(14) and (15) of Section 10 of this Act cannot be funded from current year*  
31 *resources, then such appropriations shall be funded from fund balances carried*  
32 *forward from the 1991-93 biennium in the Department of Higher Education Grants*  
33 *Fund Account.*

34

35 SECTION 35. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds

1 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
2 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
3 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and  
4 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
5 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control  
6 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the  
7 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
8 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

9

10 SECTION 36. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
11 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
12 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which  
13 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
14 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
15 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
16 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
17 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

18

19 SECTION 37. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and  
20 permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the  
21 Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

22

23 SECTION 38. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the  
24 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such  
25 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which  
26 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this  
27 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

28

29 SECTION 39. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict  
30 with this Act are hereby repealed.

31

32 SECTION 40. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
33 Seventy-Ninth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas  
34 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that  
35 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1993 is essential to the operation of

1 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
2 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective  
3 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1993 could work irreparable harm upon the  
4 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.  
5 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
6 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
7 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1993.
