# **A Bill**

**HOUSE BILL 2006**

## **For An Act To Be Entitled**

9 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE ANNOTATED § 6-17-205 TO  
10 *PROVIDE FOR REVIEW BY A SCHOOL DISTRICT COMMITTEE ON*  
11 *PERSONNEL POLICIES OF ANY PROPOSED DISTRIBUTION OF A*  
12 *SALARY UNDERPAYMENT FROM PREVIOUS YEARS. "*

## **Subtitle**

14 *"TO PROVIDE FOR REVIEW BY SCHOOL DISTRICT COMMITTEES ON*  
15 *PERSONNEL POLICIES OF PROPOSED DISTRIBUTIONS OF SALARY*  
16 *UNDERPAYMENTS. "*

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20  
21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-17-205 is hereby amended to read as  
22 follows:

23 "6-17-205. Organization and duties of committee.

24 (a) Each school district's committee on personnel policies shall  
25 organize itself in the first quarter of each school year, elect a chairman and  
26 secretary, and develop a calendar of meetings throughout the year to review  
27 the district's personnel policies to determine if additional policies or  
28 amendments to existing policies are needed, and to review any proposed  
29 distribution of a salary underpayment from previous years.

30 (b) Minutes of the committee meetings shall be promptly reported and  
31 distributed to members of the board and posted in the buildings of the  
32 district including administrative offices.

33 (c) Either the committee or the board of directors may propose new  
34 personnel policies or amendments to existing policies, if the proposals by the  
35 board have been presented to the committee at a regular or special meeting of

1 the committee at least ten (10) working days prior to presentation to the  
2 board. The committee will hold a meeting within ten (10) working days of the  
3 school board request to present a school board proposal to the committee.

4 (d) The committee will present its proposed policies or amendments to  
5 existing policies to the board of directors.

6 (e) After presentation to the board, final action may be taken at the  
7 next regular board meeting.

8 (f) The board of directors shall have the authority to *adopt, reject or*  
9 *refer* back to the committee on personnel policies for further study and  
10 revision any proposed policies or amendments to existing policies that are  
11 submitted to the board for consideration."  
12

13 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
14 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
15 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.  
16

17 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
18 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
19 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
20 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
21 act are declared to be severable.  
22

23 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
24 hereby repealed.
