**HOUSE BILL 2016**

## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND  
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION -  
10 VOCATIONAL AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION DIVISION FOR THE  
11 BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1995; AND FOR OTHER  
12 PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

14 "AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION - VOCATIONAL AND  
15 TECHNICAL EDUCATION DIVISION APPROPRIATION."  
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18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19  
20 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - VOCATIONAL, TECHNICAL AND ADULT  
21 EDUCATION. There is hereby established for the Department of Education -  
22 Vocational and Technical Education Division - Vocational, Technical and Adult  
23 Education for the 1993-95 biennium, the following maximum number of regular  
24 employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform  
25 Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its  
26 successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any  
27 position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in  
28 dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification  
29 and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are  
30 hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and  
31 Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

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11 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - VOCATIONAL, TECHNICAL AND ADULT EDUCATION.  
 12 There is hereby authorized, for the Department of Education - Vocational and  
 13 Technical Education Division - Vocational, Technical and Adult Education for  
 14 the 1993-95 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary  
 15 employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein  
 16 for such purposes: Seventy six (76) temporary or part-time employees, when  
 17 needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform  
 18 Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the  
 19 appropriate classification.

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21 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS - VOCATIONAL, TECHNICAL AND ADULT EDUCATION.  
 22 There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Education - Vocational and  
 23 Technical Education Division, to be payable from the Vocational Education

19 provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas

20 Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

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17 SECTION 8. ALLOCATION RESTRICTION. Of the amounts allocated in Section  
18 7 hereof, excluding the New Program Expenses, Program and Institutional  
19 Accreditation, Adult Education Reimbursements, Associate Degree Nursing  
20 Program, Position Pool line items, and other targeted projects as designated  
21 by the State Board of Vocational Education, such amounts are to be the maximum  
22 expended in the applicable fiscal year from the funds as appropriated in  
23 Section 6 herein for the benefit of the appropriate area vocational technical  
24 institutions, so enumerated. Provided, however, that in the event that  
25 unforeseen circumstances occur in either fiscal year that would necessitate a  
26 transfer of the maximum allocation provided in Section 7 herein from one or  
27 more programs to another program or programs as enumerated in said Section 7,  
28 the Department shall make its request known, and the reasons thereof, to the  
29 Budget Division of the Department of Finance and Administration, in such form  
30 and detail as may be required by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, and  
31 when approved, such transfer approval shall be transmitted to the Research and  
32 Fiscal Services Division of the Bureau of Legislative Research, who shall make  
33 a report of the transfer and the reasons thereof to the Arkansas Legislative  
34 Council at least quarterly. Further provided, that nothing in this Section  
35 shall be construed in such manner as to allow a transfer between any items as

1 set out in Section 6 herein; nor that any transfer request of allocations be  
2 granted unless recommended by the Director of the Vocational and Technical  
3 Education Division and the Department of Finance and Administration. The  
4 maximum amount of the transfers to or from any of the aforementioned schools  
5 shall be limited to twenty percent (20%) of the amount so allocated to the  
6 affected schools in any one fiscal year.

27 established federal accounts for educational programs financed by either or

28 both State and Federal funds for the purpose of clearing audit exceptions,

29 adjustments in matching requirements, or to provide initial program financing

30 or existing program financing pending availability of funds from the Federal

31 Government, or for the purpose of prorating direct or indirect costs are

32 hereby authorized.

33

34 SECTION 26. After the amounts to be made available to the various

35 technical institutes or comprehensive lifelong learning centers have been



1 determined by the State Board of Vocational Education under the provisions of  
2 Act 1244 of 1991 and Act 1246 of 1991, and upon the review and approval of the  
3 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, such documents as may be necessary shall be  
4 processed so that funds may be transferred from the Work Force 2000

16 SECTION 28. EXTRA HELP RESTRICTION. No employee in a Vocational  
17 Technical Institution of the Vocational and Technical Education Division,  
18 Department of Education, who is employed as "Extra Help" may receive an amount  
19 to exceed eighty-five percent (85%) of the maximum annual salary for a  
20 comparable position as authorized under Arkansas Code 21-5-201 et seq. during

24 SECTION 29. TRANSFER PROVISION. The Director, Vocational and Technical

28 item, and the Adult Education reimbursement line item provided for in Section

4 the Vocational and Technical Education Division to engage in educational  
5 projects that would be of benefit to the State of Arkansas, and that such  
6 projects make it necessary to employ additional personnel, which were not  
7 contemplated at the time of the passage of this Act, the State Board of  
8 Vocational Education, upon seeking a prior review by the Arkansas Legislative  
9 Council, shall certify to the Chief Fiscal Officer the need to establish one  
10 or more new additional positions, at salary rates not to exceed the maximum  
11 salaries established for comparable positions in the Regular Salaries Section  
12 of this Act, but in no event shall the Chief Fiscal Officer authorize the  
13 establishment of more than twenty-five (25) new or additional employees. The  
14 Chief Fiscal Officer shall certify to the State Auditor and the State  
15 Treasurer such approval of additional positions.

16

17 SECTION 31. The Department of Education - Vocational-Technical Schools  
18 shall be limited to a maximum of one hundred fifty (150) filled positions in  
19 utilizing the title of Vocational Instructor IV/Grade 20, one hundred seventy-  
20 five (175) filled positions in utilizing the title of Vocational Instructor  
21 III/Grade 19, two hundred twenty-five (225) filled positions in utilizing the  
22 title of Vocational Instructor II/Grade 18, and five (5) filled positions in  
23 utilizing the title of Vocational Instructor I/Grade 17. At no time during the  
24 1993-95 biennium shall the combined use of all titles referenced above  
25 (Vocational Instructor IV, III, II and I) exceed four hundred twenty-five

28 SECTION 32. The positions of Vo-Tech Technician II and of Vo-Tech  
29 Technician I, as authorized in Items (1) and (2) of Section 4 of this Act may  
30 be utilized only in the event that high technology programs are approved by  
31 the State Board of Vocational Education which require instructors who cannot  
32 be employed at the rates of pay approved for other vocational technical  
33 instructors. Such positions shall be restricted to use in high technology or  
34 critical skills area programs as defined by rules and regulations promulgated  
35 by the State Board.

1

2           SECTION 33. TRANSFER OF APPROPRIATION. If during either fiscal year of  
3 the 1993-95 biennium, private funds and donations, gifts, or grants become  
4 available for new, expanded, or continuing vocational-technical educational  
5 programs, the Director of the Vocational and Technical Education Division is  
6 hereby authorized to request the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State to transfer  
7 to any line item appropriation from the Vocational-Technical Schools Fund  
8 Account provided in Section 6 herein, additional appropriation provided in  
9 Section 24 herein, as needed, not to exceed the amount of funds deposited into  
10 the Vocational-Technical Education Contingency Fund and transferred to the

13           SECTION 34. PERSONNEL TRANSFER PROVISION. Any positions with  
14 supporting appropriation as authorized in Section 1 of this Act may be  
15 transferred to a vocational-technical institution as needed. Any positions  
16 with supporting appropriation as authorized in Section 4 of this Act may be  
17 transferred to the Vocational and Technical Education Division as needed.  
18 Provided, however, the maximum amount of positions or appropriations  
19 transferred shall be limited to ten percent (10%) of the total number of  
20 authorized positions and supporting appropriation for any one  
21 vocational-technical institution. The transfer of any position and supporting  
22 appropriation must be requested by the Director, Vocational and Technical  
23 Education Division, Department of Education, and any such transfer will  
24 require prior approval of the Governor and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the  
25 State. In no event shall this language be used to increase the Central Office  
26 Administration, unless the Governor determines that sufficient savings are to  
27 be effected in overall administration of the vocational programs of the State  
28 of Arkansas to justify said transfer.

29

30           SECTION 35. All funds that become available for Adult Education shall  
31 first be distributed to those administrative units determined to be operating  
32 efficient and effective adult education programs, under criteria established  
33 by the State Board of Vocational Education and shall be at the same level as  
34 expended by each unit in the most recent fiscal year for which there is  
35 complete data (hereafter referred to as base funding). The criteria shall

1 include the relative efficiency of administration of the program in the  
2 counties served. For the purposes of this Section, the term "literacy rate"  
3 shall be determined by the number of adults completing less than the twelfth  
4 grade as reported by the most recent decennial federal census. Except for  
5 special projects, 50% of the remaining monies shall be distributed based upon  
6 the literacy rate per county and 50% shall be distributed on the basis of the  
7 performance outcomes for the previous year, as established by the State Board  
8 of Vocational Education. Of the funds distributed based on literacy rate, no  
9 administrative unit shall receive funds for any county served above that  
10 county's literacy rate cap except for base funds received by efficient and  
11 effective units. Local administrative costs shall not exceed 10% of the total  
12 allocation. Unallocated funds will be redistributed based upon need as  
13 determined by the State Board of Vocational Education. Further, the State  
14 Board of Vocational Education shall give first consideration and priority in  
15 the distribution of monies set aside for special projects to counties  
16 receiving less funding by the formula.

17

18 SECTION 36. The Director of the Vocational and Technical Education  
19 Division shall be authorized, after notifying the Chief Fiscal Officer of the  
20 State, to transfer funds and appropriation from the Extra Help and Personal  
21 Services Matching line items provided for in Section 3 to any vocational  
22 technical institution line item provided in this Act or to any public  
23 community college, two-year college, or university. Provided, however, such  
24 transfer shall be limited to those funds and appropriation provided for in  
25 Section 3 which have been designated by the Vocational and Technical Education  
26 Division for apprenticeship and industry training.

27

28 SECTION 37. TRANSFER PROVISION. The Division Director for Vocational-  
29 Technical Education shall have the authority after notification of the Chief  
30 Fiscal Officer of the State to transfer the appropriation from the Associate  
31 Degree Nursing Program line item provided for in Section 6 of this Act to any  
32 other line item appropriated herein provided, however, that such transfer  
33 shall only be made to enable the Vocational-Technical Division to establish

1           SECTION 38. TRANSFER PROVISION - VOCATIONAL TECHNICAL INSTITUTIONS.  
2 The Director of the Vocational and Technical Education Division shall be  
3 authorized, after approval by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State who has  
4 sought a review by the Legislative Council, to transfer appropriation from  
5 Line Item (01), Regular Salaries, to Line Item (02), Extra Help of Section 6

18           SECTION 40. Local Boards of postsecondary vocational institutions are  
19 hereby authorized to establish salaries of the postsecondary vocational  
20 administrator up to and including the maximum allowable salary for the  
21 classification, after seeking the review of the Office of Personnel Management  
22 and the Arkansas Legislative Council. Each local board shall consider factors  
23 that include the local competitive salaries of public school superintendents,  
24 principals, community and technical college presidents, business and industry  
25 managers, and other related positions in the area as well as the  
26 president's/director's performance, experience and preparation.

27

28 In the event that any postsecondary vocational institution merges with a  
29 contiguous community college, the director of the vocational institute shall  
30 become eligible for a \$10,000 increase in annual salary and the assistant  
31 director shall become eligible for a \$5,000 increase in annual salary  
32 following such a merger.

33

34           SECTION 41. SPECIAL RATES OF PAY. Due to highly competitive job market  
35 conditions and the necessity of recruiting and retaining qualified personnel,

1 the Arkansas Department of Education - Vocational and Technical Education  
2 Division is authorized special rates of pay for current and new employees up  
3 to levels listed under subsection (b) below. Special rates of pay may be  
4 requested subject to the following restrictions:

6 (a) that applications for special rates of pay shall have been reviewed  
7 and approved by the Office of Personnel Management after seeking prior review

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SECTION 44. REGULAR SALARIES. SECTION 46. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds



1 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency

19 SECTION 48. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and  
20 permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the

23 SECTION 49. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the  
24 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such  
25 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which  
26 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this  
27 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

29 SECTION 50. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict  
30 with this Act are hereby repealed.

32 SECTION 51. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
33 Seventy-Ninth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas  
34 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that  
35 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1993 is essential to the operation of

1 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
2 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective  
3 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1993 could work irreparable harm upon the  
4 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.  
5 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
6 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
7 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1993.
