7 **For An Act To Be Entitled**

8 "AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT IN COUNTIES WITH MULTIPLE CIRCUIT
9 AND/OR CHANCERY COURTS, CASES WILL BE ASSIGNED ON AN
10 IMPARTIAL ROTATION BASIS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

12 **Subtitle**

13 "AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT IN COUNTIES WITH MULTIPLE CIRCUIT
14 AND/OR CHANCERY COURTS, CASES WILL BE ASSIGNED ON AN
15 IMPARTIAL ROTATION BASIS."

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

18

19 SECTION 1. The Administrative Office of the Courts shall as soon as
20 possible establish procedures whereby in counties which have multiple circuit
21 courts and/or multiple chancery courts, cases will be assigned on an impartial
22 rotation basis. All circuit and chancery court judges shall abide by the
23 procedures established by the Administrative Office of the Courts pursuant to
24 this act.

25

26 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
27 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
28 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

29

30 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
31 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
32 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
33 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
34 act are declared to be severable.

1 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
2 hereby repealed.
