8 *"AN ACT TO SPECIFY THE PARTY RESPONSIBLE FOR COLLECTING*
9 *AND ACCOUNTING FOR FUNDS COLLECTED PURSUANT TO CERTAIN*
10 *PROVISIONS OF THE JUVENILE CODE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."*

Subtitle

13 *"SPECIFYING THE PARTY RESPONSIBLE FOR COLLECTING AND*
14 *ACCOUNTING FOR CERTAIN FUNDS UNDER THE JUVENILE CODE."*

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

18 *SECTION 1. (a) The circuit/chancery clerk in each county shall collect*
19 *and account for all filing fees pursuant to Arkansas Code 9-27-310 and 311.*

20 *(b) The circuit clerk in each county shall collect and account for*
21 *attorney's fees for the Juvenile Court Representation Fund pursuant to*
22 *Arkansas Code 9-27-316.*

23 *(c) The sheriffs in each county shall collect and account for the*
24 *following:*

25 *(1) court costs pursuant to Arkansas Code 9-27-330(5);*

26 *(2) juvenile restitution pursuant to Arkansas Code 9-27-330(6);*

27 *(3) juvenile fines pursuant to Arkansas Code 9-27-330(7);*

28 *(4) juvenile probation fees pursuant to Arkansas Code 16-13-326;*

29 *and*

30 *(5) juvenile money bonds and forfeitures pursuant to Arkansas Code*
31 *9-27-326(e)(3).*

33 *SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature*
34 *are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code*
35 *Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.*
