8 "TO PROVIDE THAT THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL SHALL ESTABLISH
9 AN ORIENTATION PROGRAM FOR NEWLY-ELECTED LEGISLATORS WHICH
10 SHALL INCLUDE ON-SITE VISITS TO STATE AGENCIES AND
11 INSTITUTIONS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

14 "LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ESTABLISH AN ORIENTATION PROGRAM FOR
15 NEWLY-ELECTED LEGISLATORS TO INCLUDE ON-SITE VISITS TO
16 STATE AGENCIES & INSTITUTIONS."

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 SECTION 1. The Legislative Council is hereby directed to establish an
21 orientation program for newly-elected members of the General Assembly which
22 program shall include on-site visits to state agencies and institutions. The
23 on-site visits shall occur between the date of the general election and the
24 convening of the next regular session of the General Assembly. The newly-
25 elected legislators shall be entitled to per diem and mileage for attending
26 the orientation session in the same amounts as members of the General Assembly
27 receive for attending joint interim committee meetings. Furthermore, such per
28 diem and mileage shall be paid from funds appropriated for members of the
29 General Assembly for attending meetings of joint interim committees.

30

31 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
32 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
33 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

34

35 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to

1 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
2 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
3 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
4 act are declared to be severable.

5

6 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
7 hereby repealed.
