HOUSE BILL

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE ANNOTATED § 24-8-303 TO
9 AUTHORIZE AN INCREASE IN FEES THAT A MUNICIPALITY MAY
10 COLLECT TO PROVIDE RETIREMENT BENEFITS FOR MUNICIPAL COURT
11 JUDGES AND MUNICIPAL COURT CLERKS; AND FOR OTHER
12 PURPOSES."

14 "AUTHORIZING AN INCREASE IN FEES THAT MUNICIPALITIES MAY
15 COLLECT FOR RETIREMENT BENEFITS FOR MUNICIPAL COURT JUDGES
16 AND CLERKS."

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 24-8-303(b) is hereby amended to read as
22 follows:

23 "(b) In any municipality located in a county having a population of at
24 least sixteen thousand five hundred (16,500) but not more than sixteen
25 thousand nine hundred (16,900) or in any county or in any municipality located
26 in a county having a population of at least twenty-six thousand five hundred
27 (26,500) but not more than twenty-six thousand seven hundred and fifty
28 (26,750), according to the 1980 Federal Decennial Census, the governing body
29 of the municipality may, in lieu of the levy provided for in subsection (a) of
30 this section, levy a fee of up to four dollars (\$4.00) for entering upon the
31 records of the court each criminal case and each moving traffic violation and
32 a fee of up to two dollars (\$2.00) for the issuance of each summons in a civil
33 action."

35 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature

1 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
2 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

4 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
5 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
6 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
7 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
8 act are declared to be severable.

9

10 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
11 hereby repealed.
