HOUSE BILL

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For An Act To Be Entitled

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8 "AN ACT TO TRANSFER THE STATE BOARD OF PRIVATE CAREER EDUCATION
9 AND ALL RESPONSIBILITIES PERTAINING THERETO TO THE DEPARTMENT
10 OF EDUCATION - VOCATIONAL AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION DIVISION; AND
11 FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

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Subtitle

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14 "AN ACT TO TRANSFER THE STATE BOARD OF PRIVATE CAREER EDUCATION
15 TO THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION - VOCATIONAL AND TECHNICAL
16 EDUCATION DIVISION."

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18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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20 SECTION 1. Effective July 1, 1993, the State Board of Private Career Education shall be transferred by a Type 2 transfer as
21 provided in A.C.A. 25-2-105 to the Department of Education - Vocational and Technical Education Division.

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23 SECTION 2. All powers, duties, functions, records, property, appropriations, and funds administered or provided for the
24 State Board of Private Career Education shall be transferred to the Department of Education - Vocational and Technical Education Division
25 upon the effective date of the transfer.

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27 SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this Act shall be limited to
28 the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State
29 Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures
30 and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the
31 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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33 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the
34 authority of the appropriations contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this Act was adopted, as evidenced
35 by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the

1 Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
2 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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4 **SECTION 5. CODE.** All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of
5 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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7 **SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY.** If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held
8 invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or
9 application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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11 **SECTION 7. GENERAL REPEALER.** All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

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13 **SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE.** It is hereby found and determined by the Seventy-Ninth General Assembly meeting in
14 Regular Session, that the provisions of this Act are of critical importance to preserve the efficient operation of programs that deliver services to
15 the citizens of the State of Arkansas. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act being necessary for the immediate
16 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

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
